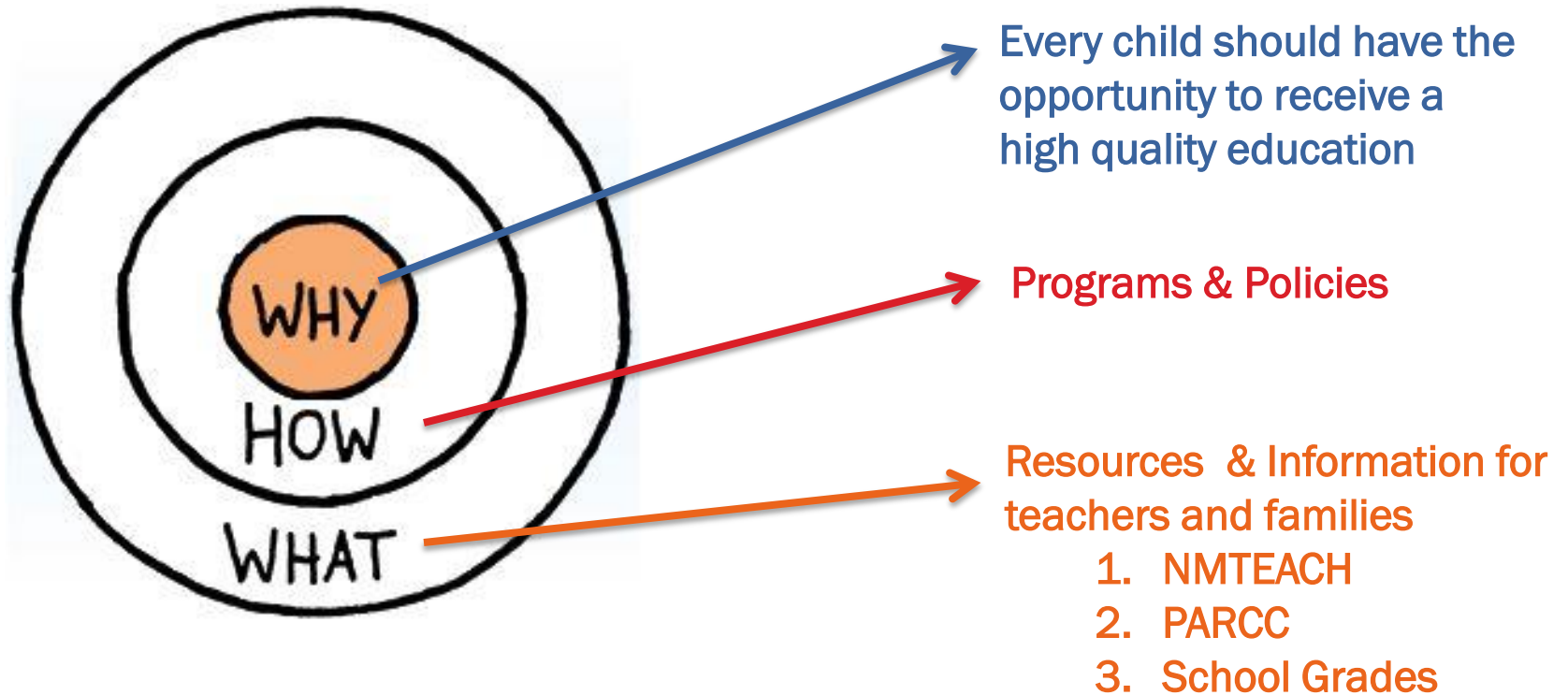

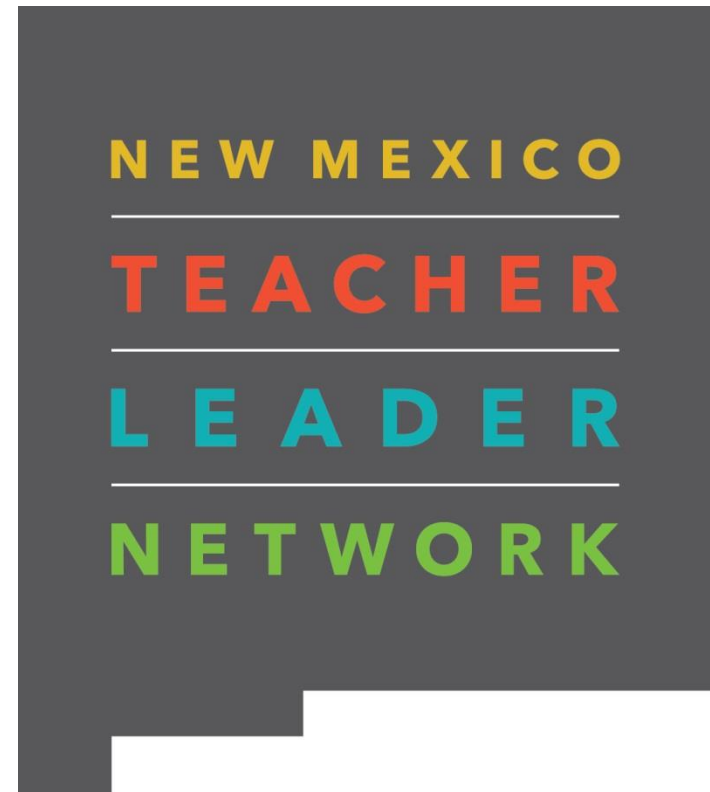
NEW MEXICO TEACHER LEADER NETWORK

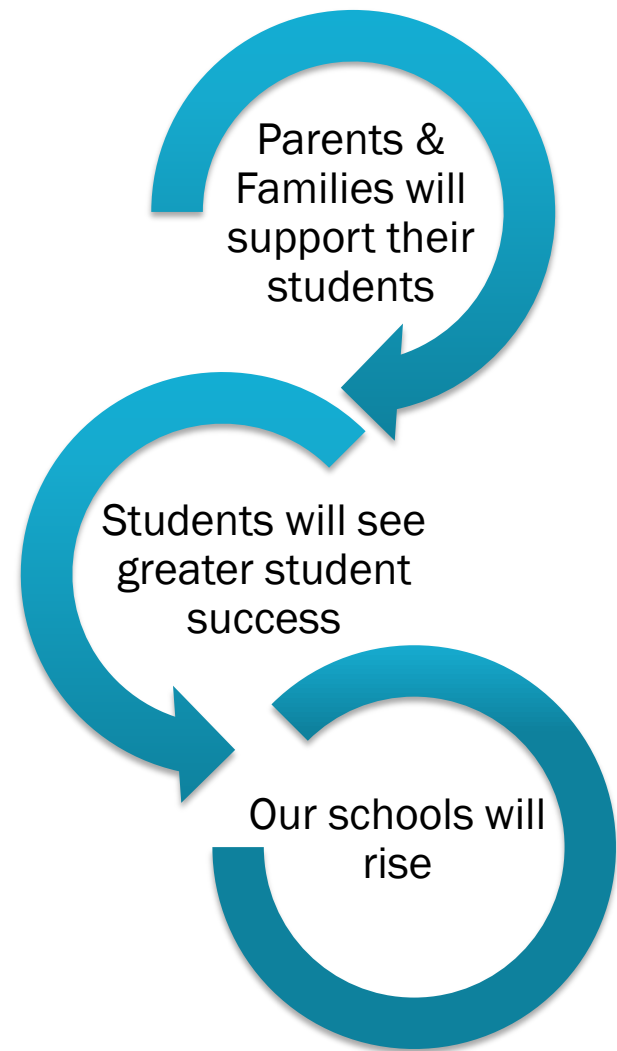

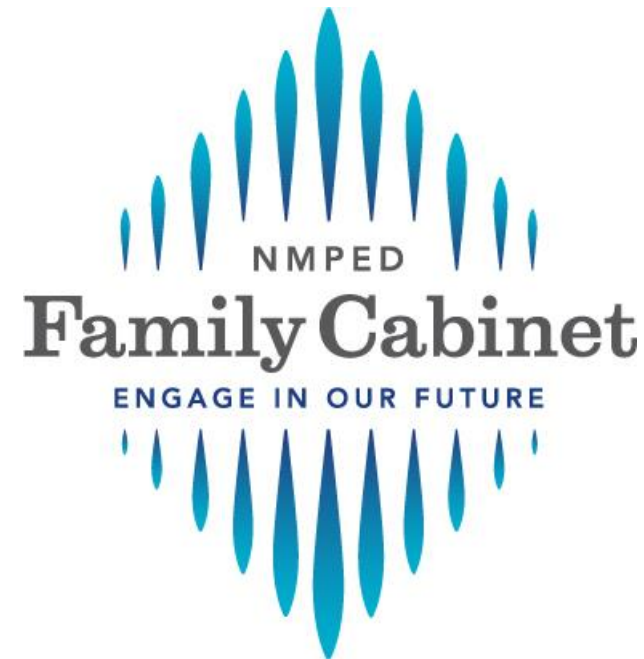


PED FAMILY CABINET

- Share information with their local school, district, and community



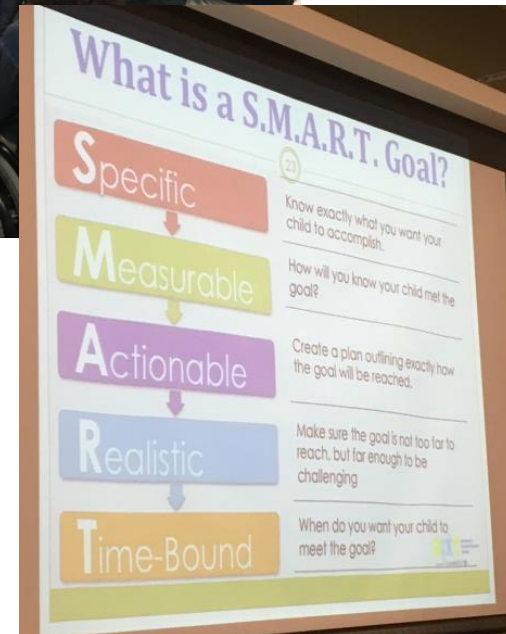
ACADEMIC PARENT TEACHER TEAMS (APTT)

- Classroom based
- Linked to learning
- Systematic and integrated
- Collaborative (Team Approach)
- Targeting every child/every family

FAMILIES WILL:

- Learn grade level foundational skills
- Review data and understand their child's current progress in the skills
- Practice the foundational skills with other families
- Set learning goals for their child
