Dear Secretary Skandera:

In accordance with NMSA 22-15-8, the Instructional Material Bureau has conducted the 2016 summer review institute of grades K–12 social studies materials for adoption as core basal (CB). In addition, reference and New Mexico Native American art and culture materials were accepted but not reviewed for adoption as CB. The reviews were conducted during the 2016 summer review institute in Bernalillo, from June 5 through June 10, 2016. The reviewers were Level II and III teachers and administrators.

Of the 44 titles submitted for review at the summer institute, 24 are recommended for adoption as CB and 20 are recommended for adoption as supplemental (SU). The 24 titles that have been recommended as CB align—at 90 percent or better—with New Mexico academic content and performance standards and other relevant criteria. Materials recommended as CB include student and teacher editions, student workbooks, or a bundle that consists of the student edition and/or teacher edition of a title. Materials recommended as SU are either reviewed—but did not align with the standards at 90 percent or better, are not submitted for review by the publisher, or are classified as ancillary materials. Materials may be print, digital, or both.

Attached, you will find the results of the summer review institute and a listing of each title submitted for recommendation as either CB or SU. These constitute the Multiple List.
