Dear Secretary Skandera:

In accordance with NMSA 22-15-8, the Instructional Material Bureau has conducted the 2015 review for the adoption of grades K–8 English language arts; reading; Core reading intervention; and Modern, Classical, and Native languages instructional materials. The reviews were conducted during the 2015 summer review institute in Albuquerque, from June 1 through June 5, 2015. The reviewers included Level II and III teachers and administrators.

Of the 96 titles submitted for review at the summer institute, 90 are recommended for adoption as core/basal (CB), and 6 are recommended for adoption as supplemental (SU). The 90 titles that have been recommended as CB align—at 90 percent or better—with New Mexico academic content and performance standards, including Common Core State Standards. Materials recommended as CB include student and teacher editions, student workbooks, or a bundle that consists of the student edition and/or teacher edition of a title that has been submitted for CB consideration. Materials recommended as SU were either reviewed—but did not align with the standards at 90 percent or better, were not submitted for review by the publisher, or were classified as ancillary materials.

Attached, you will find a listing of each discrete title submitted for recommendation as either CB or SU. These constitute the Multiple List.
