SECTION III: NARRATIVE

HB34 amends Section 12-5-2 NMSA 1978 and proposes a public holiday on the first Friday in April of every year in honor of Dennis Chavez and Cesar Chavez.

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: HB 34 adds a proposed public holiday, Dennis Chavez and Cesar Chavez Day, to the current list of legal public holidays. Section one of HB34, adds Dennis Chavez and Cesar Chavez Day to the current list of 10 legal public holidays in New Mexico between President's Day and Memorial Day. Section two of HB34, add a new section to Chapter 12, Article 5 NMSA that provides a description of Dennis Chavez and Cesar Chavez Day. Section three of HB34, provides legislative findings in the form of biographies for both Dennis Chavez, Subsection B, and Cesar Chavez, Subsection C.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

HB34 would add an additional public holiday to Section 12-5-2 NMSA 1978 that may require an additional paid holiday for government employees.
