## Standards Based Assessment (SBA) for Science

The current year is the final year of SBA administration in Grades 4, 7, and 11. The test administration procedure will be similar to last year. For the senior retest window, District Test Coordinators can order fall retest materials via the iServices portal at: http://iservices.measuredprogress.org.

Starting in SY 2019-20, the state will administer the New Mexico Assessment of Science Readiness (NM-ASR) to measure student outcomes in the NM STEM Ready! Science Standards—in Grades 5, 8, and 11. In preparation for the SY 2019-20 operational NM-ASR, a field test will be administered for a subset of districts and charter schools in Spring 2019. Additional information will be provided for schools identified to participate in the field test.

# End of Course (EOC) NM STEM-Ready! Science Assessments

New Mexico's full adoption of NM STEM Ready! Science Standards became effective on July 1, 2018. NM STEM Ready! Science EOCs for SY 2018–2019 will be comprised of items from the state's existing item banks; however, these items will be aligned only to the content of the updated state standards.

Correct linkages ensure students are taking the correct exam.
