**RE: 6.19.9 Early Literacy Remediation, Interventions, and Family Engagement**

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This is a notification regarding Rule 6.19.9 NMAC Early Literacy Remediation, Interventions, and Family Engagement.

The Public Education Department (PED), with the valued participation of esteemed individuals forming a taskforce, reviewed recently enacted NMAC rules. Following that review, PED determined that it will immediately proceed with repealing Rule 6.19.9 NMAC, in its entirety.

As the process to repeal the rule moves forward, there is no need to provide PED with a list of Student Assistance Team meetings convened nor the number of notification letters sent to students' families. Additionally, we will not be collecting the numbers for kindergarten through third grade students considered not proficient by the mid-year assessment.

The PED looks forward to working with stakeholders to inform future policy and procedures regarding early literacy assessment and family engagement. It is our desire to collectively build systems of support for early literacy and biliteracy in addition to creating mechanisms for accountability driven by district needs.
