Tribal Education Priorities

At 3:00 pm on November 22, 2019, Tribal Leaders caucused again, to recommend their top priorities.

➤ **Would request the presence of Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham at next G2G meeting.**
Requesting G2G Spring 2020 Agenda earlier; save the date is not sufficient.

➤ **Fill Indian Education Secretary and other vacant positions.**
Requesting NM PED have a written response on the status of filling of positions
Requesting meeting quarterly on G2G basis may improve momentum (they realize this would require amending the Indian Education Act)

➤ **Written report out on the status of the priority/recommendation list**

➤ **Evaluate NMPED office and systems in place**

- List outlined its’ initial purpose
- Track progress of list; how do you align the list with NMPED priorities
- Leadership Institute/Regis Pecos went through HB250- is there any updates from that convening?
- Need to separate the legislative versus the programmatic
