# Needs Assessment

- ❑ Focuses on outcomes to be attained, rather than the process
- ❑ Sets priorities and determines criteria for solutions
  - ❑ Sound decisions can be made
- ❑ Sets criteria for determining how best to allocate available money, or people
- ❑ Leads to action that will improve programs, services, organizations structure, or a combination
