Current Standard as Written:

The online teacher promotes learner success through interactions with learners and other stakeholders and by facilitating meaningful learner engagement in learning activities.

New Mexico Version:

The online teacher promotes the success of diverse learners through consistent interactions with learners and other stakeholders (parents/guardians, special education teachers, related service providers, etc.) by facilitating and engaging learners with developmentally appropriate, New Mexico State specific standards aligned, and differentiated learning instruction.

Standard B: Digital Pedagogy:

Current Standard as Written:

The online teacher supports learning and facilitates presence (teacher, social, and learner) with digital pedagogy.

New Mexico Version:

The online teacher has a basic understanding of educational technology and supports learning through digital pedagogy best practices as well as establishes a culture of learning regarding a learner’s academic, social, and emotional needs.
