

State-Issued Student ID Numbers (STARS IDs)

The method for obtaining a State Student ID (STARS ID) depends on the school your student currently attends:

- If your student is currently registered for **home school**, please login to your home school system account (<https://homeschool.ped.state.nm.us>) to see if a STARS ID was already issued. From the Parent menu, you can view/print enrollment which has a field for State Student ID. If the State Student ID field is blank, please email info.homeschool@state.nm.us with the following details:
 - First, Middle, Last Name of Student
 - Date of birth
 - Gender
 - Race/Ethnicity: Asian, Black (non-Hispanic), Caucasian (non-Hispanic), Hispanic, American Indian or Alaskan Native, OR Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander.
 - Last grade level completed.

Once assigned, an email will be sent to the email on record advising you to login to the online database to obtain the State Student ID.

- If attending a **public school**, please contact the school or district office.
- If attending a **private school**, please contact the postsecondary institution who will contact our office. (For security reasons, we cannot distribute confidential data to an unknown email address as there is no way to verify your identity.) The postsecondary institution shall email info.homeschool@state.nm.us with the following information for each student:
 - First, Middle, Last name of Student
 - Date of birth
 - Gender
 - Race/Ethnicity: Asian, Black (non-Hispanic), Caucasian (non-Hispanic), Hispanic, American Indian or Alaskan Native, OR Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander.
 - Last grade level completed.

Once assigned, an email with the STARS IDs will be sent to the postsecondary institution.
