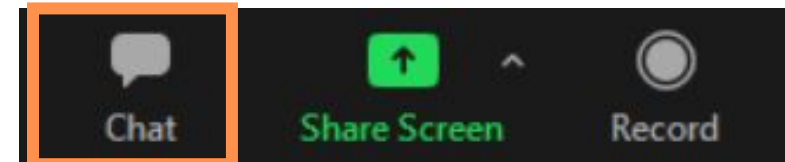

- Microphone and camera controls are located in the lower left corner of the Zoom screen.

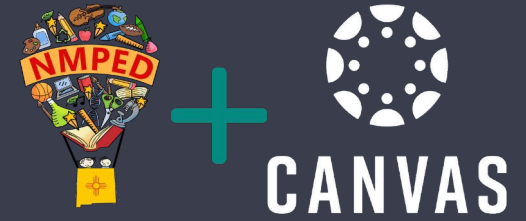


- In smaller meetings, you may wish to unmute your microphone (if allowed). If you do so, please mute yourself when done speaking.

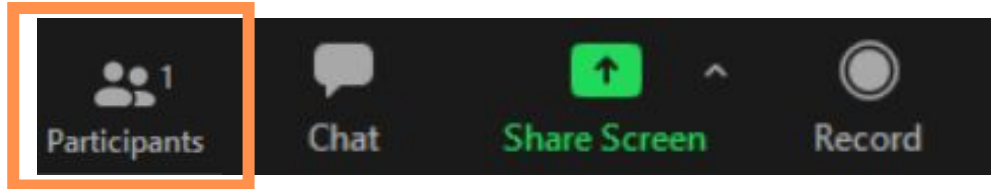

- The chat window can be accessed by clicking the Chat icon at the bottom of the Zoom screen.



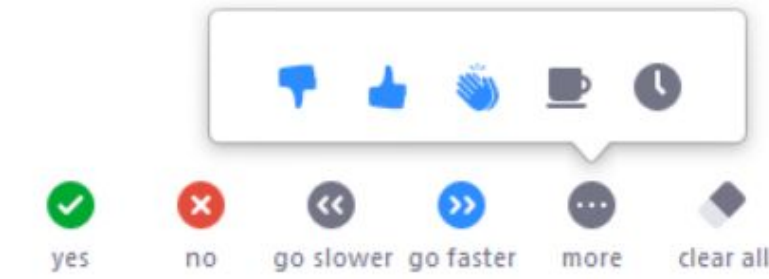

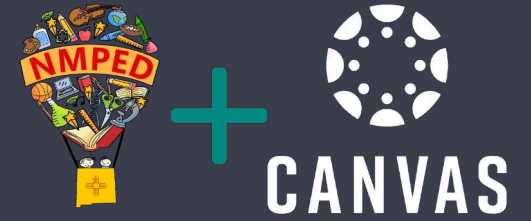
- The Participant icon allows non-verbal communication.



- Clicking the Participant icon opens the Participant window to see all participants and access these buttons at the bottom of the Zoom screen.

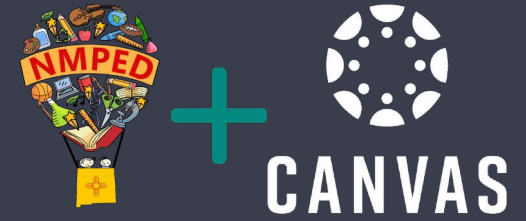

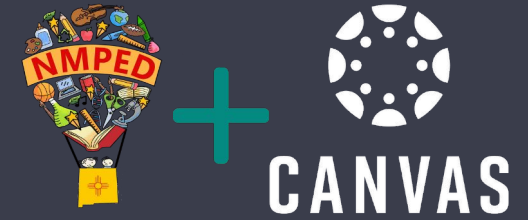
Welcome to Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) - Instructionally Embedded Assessments!

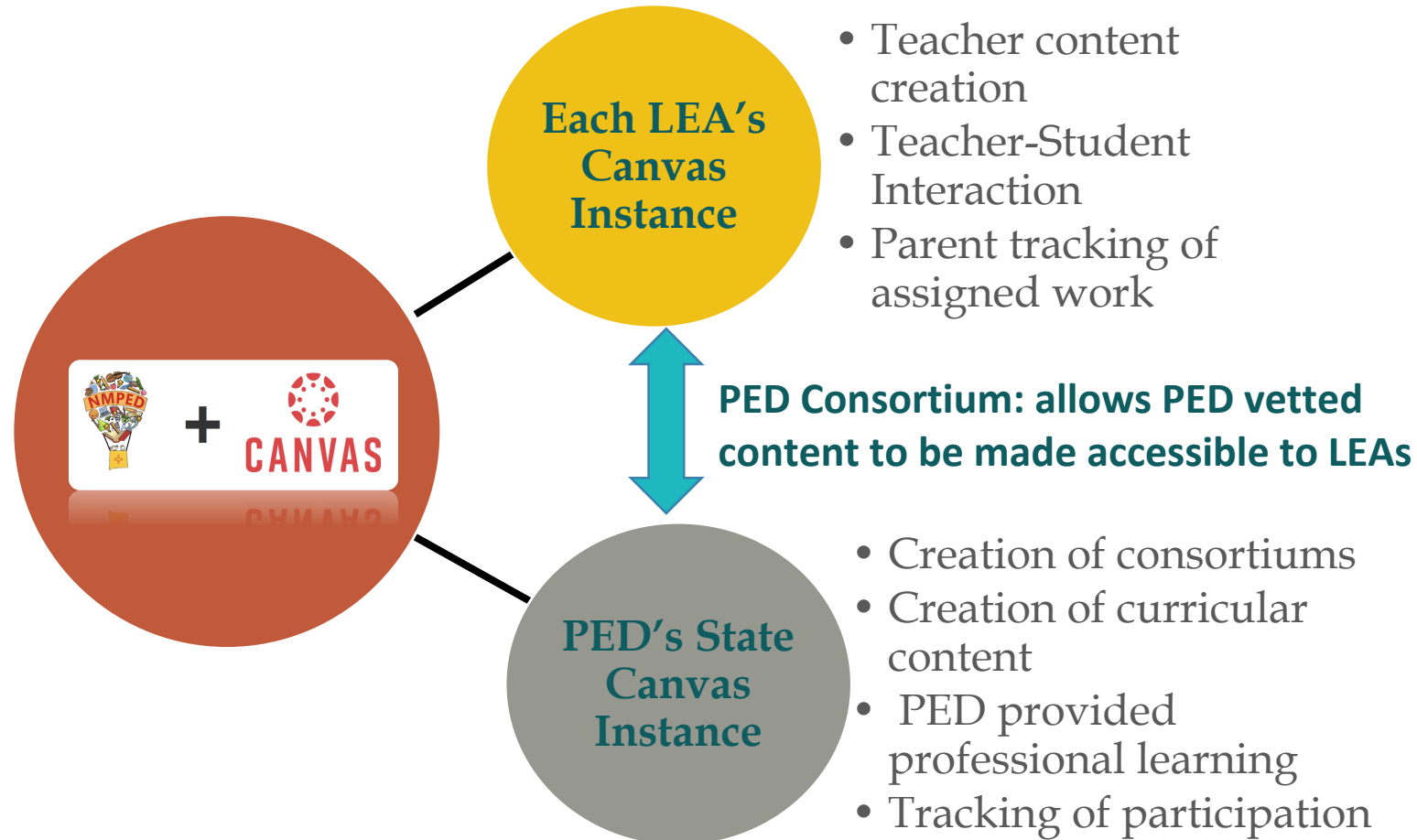
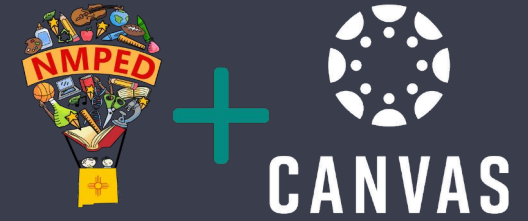
Canvas is a Learning Management System (LMS) designed to simplify teaching and learning by connecting all of the digital tools teachers and students use in one easy place. Although meant to be used online, there are features that allow for the downloading of materials for learning in an offline environment.

There are two main options through Canvas for viewing course content: ePub and HTML. You must choose one or the other in order to use one properly. **Both options may not be “turned on.”** Here is the [Canvas guide](#) to enable and allow for exporting offline in Global Settings. If you choose to use ePub, use this [Canvas guide](#) to show you how to turn on this feature. There is a third option that involves use of google drive and folders solely. See that option [here](#) as well (this document was created by OCPS-VA and shared with their permission).

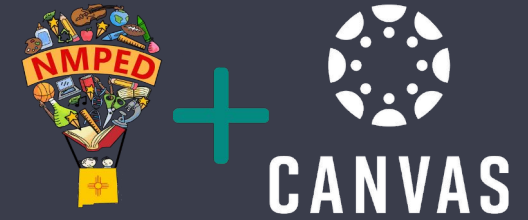

Canvas Structure Between PED & LEAs



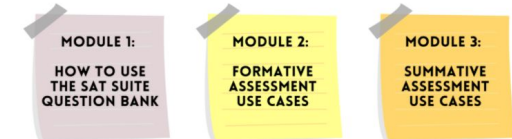

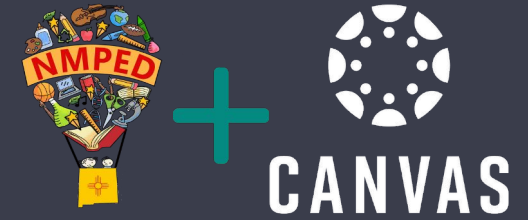

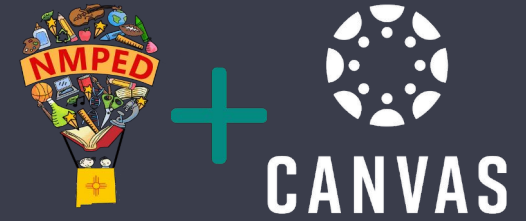


Ways to Get Involved

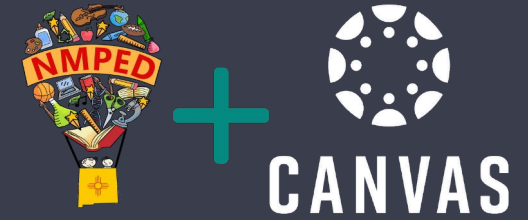
