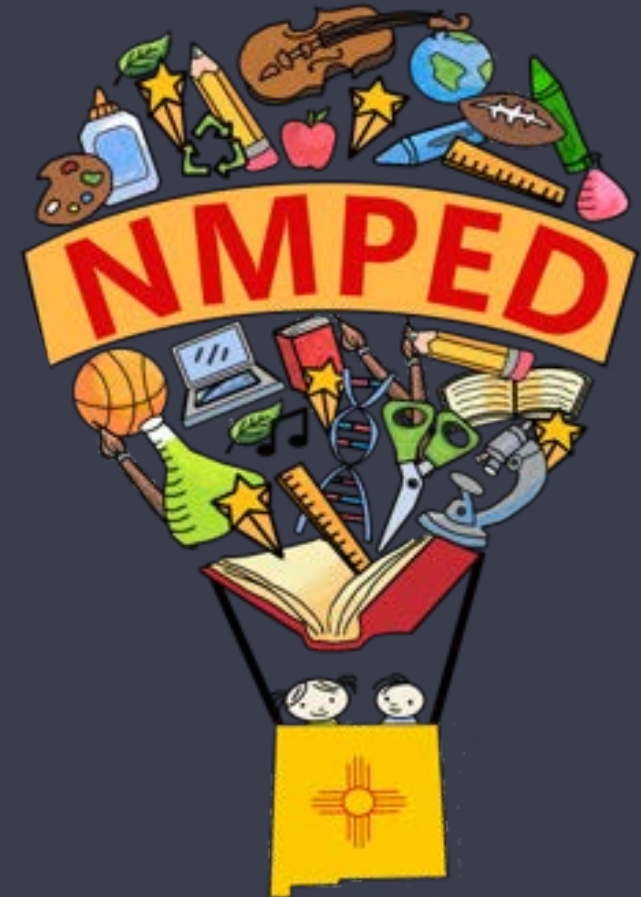

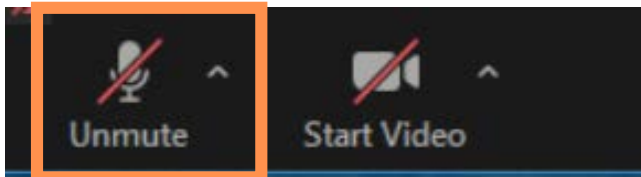

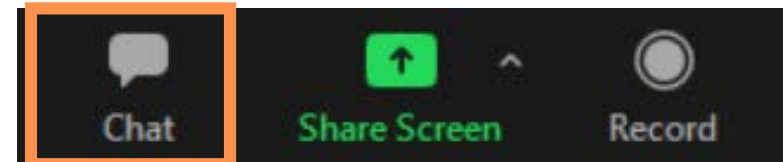
# Participating in a session

- Your microphone may have been muted by the Host. This is to prevent background noise and other unwanted sound.
- Microphone and camera controls are located in the lower left corner of the Zoom screen.



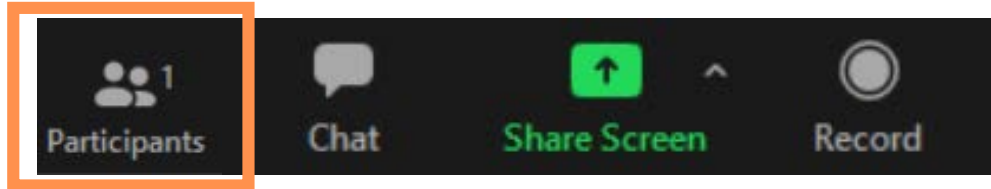
- In smaller meetings, you may wish to unmute your microphone (if allowed). If you do so, please mute yourself when done speaking.

- Chat is the preferred way to communicate with the Host in larger meetings, as it is less disruptive and allows you to post thoughts and questions as they arise, versus waiting for an opportune time to interrupt the speaker.
- The chat window can be accessed by clicking the Chat icon at the bottom of the Zoom screen.

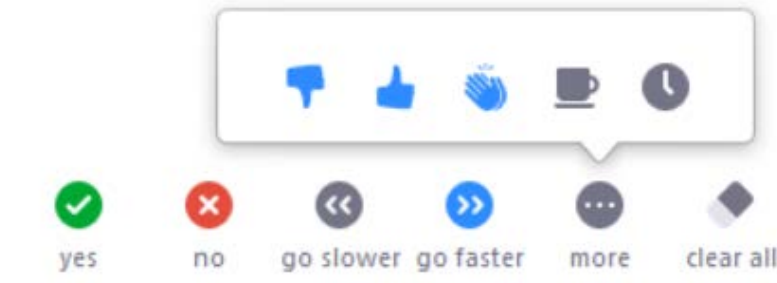


# Participating in a session (*cont.*)

- The Participant icon allows non-verbal communication.



- Clicking the Participant icon opens the Participant window to see all participants and access these buttons at the bottom of the Zoom screen.

# What is the SAT Suite Question Bank?

- The SAT Suite Question Bank (SSQB) is a question bank that includes over 3,500 real SAT/PSAT questions that have been released over the years.
- The question bank allows you to:
  - Search for questions from any assessment, even those your students haven't taken.
  - Find every question that meets your criteria, even if they appeared on different test forms.
  - View the content and answer explanations for every question in the bank.
  - Do all of this without signing in.

# Use Cases

- Use Cases of SSQB for **Formative** Assessment Purposes:
  1. Readiness pre-assessment—before instruction
  2. Warm-up activities (e.g., Question of the Day)—before instruction
  3. Formative assessment probes—during instruction
  4. Address typical misconceptions—during instruction
  5. Exit tickets—after instruction



# Use Cases

- Use Cases of SSQB for **Summative** Classroom Assessment:
  1. Supplement an existing summative assessment.
  2. Determine students' ability to generalize knowledge and skills to solve novel problems or respond to new texts.
  3. Provide educators with examples of high-quality items measuring targeted knowledge and skills within the content domain.
