

Yes	Multi-ply cloth masks available and utilized by all staff and students, over the nose and mouth, secure under the chin, snug on face with no gaps.	Extra disposable masks on hand? Mask on hand extras being kept by District Supervisor Register Nurse.
Yes	Classrooms and commons areas are set up for 6 feet social distancing with 50% student enrollment in place.	Are desk marked for A/B cohorts? Are desks/ students facing one direction? Desk are facing one direction. Desk are not marked students on alternative days.
Yes	If applicable, cafeteria (or other congregate feeding area) is set up for 6 feet social distancing and cohorts of students are not mixed.	Student broken into two teams yellow and blue, student shall be able to eat on alternative days in class room and cafeteria.
Yes	Hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol is available across the school and ample cleaning supplies in place. Soap and supplies in bathrooms are ample with reliable running water.	bathrooms spaced with some stalls and sinks shut down to maintain social distancing. 65% in each classroom.
Yes	Sanitization protocols in place that address daily cleaning and disinfection with particular attention to frequently touched surfaces including both building, playground and buses.	Sanitization logs accessible and posted across the school site? Daily cleaning of all common areas and disinfection on Monday. When students return cleaning done on Weds and Thursday. Sanitation log is kept by staff.
Yes	School doors and windows are operable and other air filtration measures in place.	Air purifiers in place. HVAC system is able to meet air filtration needs.
No	School ventilation systems are functional and meet standard.	MERV 10 ordered merv 13 install scheduled for first week of February. School ventilation system is functioning.
Yes	Evacuation plan in place that maintains 6 feet social distancing. Dismissal process in place that maintains social distancing.	Students have an assigned dismissal time, as well as floor signage both in school and the evacuation area to keep distance.
Yes	Isolation rooms for symptomatic individuals in place and protocols for students exhibiting symptoms on buses in place.	
Yes	Protocols and signage in place for entrance into the building including temperature other symptoms check.	Students shall enter through Cafeteria, all staff and students shall walk through a safe check walk in scanner. 70 students per min. Health assistants shall be on site to help the check in process and escort any students who are above temp.
Yes	Signage across the school site that includes expectations for prevention practices: frequently washing hands, avoiding touching eyes, nose, and mouth, wearing masks, staying 6 feet apart and direction of traffic.	Signage in multiple languages as appropriate? Signs are appropriate.
General Notes: school has shut down water fountains and installed water bottle refill stations in addition to providing water bottles.
