



Yes	Multi-ply cloth masks available and utilized by all staff and students, over the nose and mouth, secure under the chin, snug on face with no gaps.	Disposable PPE stored in the nurse's office with a larger centralized stock stored at the Central Office. Nurses submit requisitions for replacement PPE weekly.
Yes	Classrooms and commons areas are set up for 6 feet social distancing with 50% student enrollment in place.	Classrooms have a variety of solutions. Some utilize spacing, some marking, some have upended desks showing where they cannot sit. All are at the 6 ft. Built-ins (chemistry) are marked.
Yes	If applicable, cafeteria (or other congregate feeding area) is set up for 6 feet social distancing and cohorts of students are not mixed.	Lunches are a mix of in-person cafeteria, in class, and outside. Cafeteria is faced one direction.
Yes	Hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol is available across the school and ample cleaning supplies in place. Soap and supplies in bathrooms are ample with reliable running water.	See photographic examples. 70% alcohol. Bathrooms are good and supplied.
Yes	Sanitization protocols in place that address daily cleaning and disinfection with particular attention to frequently touched surfaces including both building, playground and buses.	See COVID 19 Support Guide (pg. 4-6). Daily cleanings by teachers and custodians. High touch areas cleaned more often.
Yes	School doors and windows are operable and other air filtration measures in place.	System is capable of moving air 3X per hour per classroom.
Yes	School ventilation systems are functional and meet standard.	MERV13 See PO
Yes	Evacuation plan in place that maintains 6 feet social distancing. Dismissal process in place that maintains social distancing.	See COVID 19 Support Guide (pg. 7). Grades and classes will be staggered for exit and taken to a designated area so that groups don't mix. This schools will dismiss by mode of transportation (buses, walkers, drivers). Monitors outside will help with distancing.
Yes	Isolation rooms for symptomatic individuals in place and protocols for students exhibiting symptoms on buses in place.	See COVID Support Guide. The isolation room is adjacent and students on a bus are taken straight to the room.

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yes	Protocols and signage in place for entrance into the building including temperature other symptoms check.	See COVID 19 Support Guide (pg. 7, 19-22). This school is signed similar to the examples.
yes	Signage across the school site that includes expectations for prevention practices: frequently washing hands, avoiding touching eyes, nose, and mouth, wearing masks, staying 6 feet apart and direction of traffic.	See COVID 19 Support Guide (pg. 17). This school is signed similar to the examples.
