

Yes	Multi-ply cloth masks available and utilized by all staff and students, over the nose and mouth, secure under the chin, snug on face with no gaps.	Extra disposable masks on hand? Ruidoso High School has over 2600 masks on hand with the ability to reorder and restock as needed. The school is allowing staff and students to wear their own personal multi-layered masks, therefore, it is anticipated that the stock of disposable masks will last quite awhile.
Yes	Classrooms and commons areas are set up for 6 feet social distancing with 50% student enrollment in place.	Are desks marked for A/B cohorts? Yes. Are desks/ students facing one direction? Yes. RHS will use a 50/50 hybrid model. "A" cohort will attend Monday and Tuesday. "B" will attend Thursday and Friday with cleaning days on Wednesday and Saturday.
Yes	If applicable, cafeteria (or other congregate feeding area) is set up for 6 feet social distancing and cohorts of students are not mixed.	Breakfast and lunch will be grab-and-go and the students will eat in the cafeteria and other common areas which are set up to allow for only one student per table. The tables are adequately spaced.
Yes	Hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol is available across the school and ample cleaning supplies in place. Soap and supplies in bathrooms are ample with reliable running water.	All observed hand sanitizer is commercially produced and 70% alcohol. The school has a system for reordering and restocking as needed.
Yes	Sanitization protocols in place that address daily cleaning and disinfection with particular attention to frequently touched surfaces including both building, playground and buses.	Sanitization logs accessible and posted across the school site? Cleaning/sanitizing log books are kept in each classroom and are maintained by the faculty. Scheduled intervals for cleaning are detailed therein.
Yes	School doors and windows are operable and other air filtration measures in place.	Air purifiers in place. No in room purifiers are in place. Adequate and well maintained ventilation is produced mainly by the HVAC systems.
Yes	School ventilation systems are functional and meet standard.	Ventilation systems are operational and use MERV 13 filtration.
Yes	Evacuation plan in place that maintains 6 feet social distancing. Dismissal process in place that maintains social distancing.	RHS has amended their usual evacuation/lockdown procedures to allow for social distancing. They have expanded their usual gathering locations to allow for COVID specific distancing.
Yes	Isolation rooms for symptomatic individuals in place and protocols for students exhibiting symptoms on buses in place.	There is one isolation room with the ability to expand to three rooms if so needed.
Yes	Protocols and signage in place for entrance into the building including temperature other symptoms check.	Signage for one-way paths of travel, temp stations, and distance spacing upon entry.
Yes	Signage across the school site that includes expectations for prevention practices: frequently washing hands, avoiding touching eyes, nose, and mouth, wearing masks, staying 6 feet apart and direction of traffic.	Signage in multiple languages as appropriate? Yes
