BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: Senate Bill 139 (SB139) would appropriate \$100,000 to the Public Education Department (PED) for operational improvements for the KANW radio station.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SB139 would appropriate \$100,000 to the PED for operational improvements for the KANW radio station. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2022 shall revert to the general fund.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The KANW radio station is a non-profit, non-commercial public radio station owned and operated by Albuquerque Public Schools (APS). It is unclear what specific operational improvements would be made with the funding.
