	<b>General Notes:</b> The school serves 179 students in grades 6,7,8 start with 6th graders (who have never been on campus), then re choosing to stay remote (60%). Deep cleaning occurs on Wedne COVID-safe checklist, teacher surface cleaning kits and Air Pu outdoor space for PE will also be used. Students are assigned to <b>16th.</b>
