RE: **Accessing Spring 2021 Student Assessment Results**

This memorandum provides District Test Coordinators (DTCs) information on accessing individual student reports (ISRs) from the spring 2021 flexible test administration. Please note the specific announcements for each federal assessment program.

Assessment of Science Readiness (ASR)

As a reminder to DTCs, no ASR reports are available from the spring 2021 administration due to low participation rates. Standard setting, the determination of proficiency levels, will occur following the spring 2022 operational administration.

ACCESS for ELLs & Alternate ACCESS

- ACCESS data is available on August 31, 2021 through the [Assessment Management System \(AMS\) portal](#).
- DTCs are required to conduct a post reporting data validation starting September 10, 2021.
- Printed ISRs are due to arrive in district near September 14, 2021.

Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM)

- Data from the Dynamic Learning Maps assessment (DLM) will be available on July 27, 2021, through the [Kite Educator Portal](#).
- Online ISRs are available for download; DLM does not ship printed reports to districts.
- Score report explanation guides for parents are available in [English](#) and [Spanish](#).

Measures of Student Success and Achievement (MSSA)

Given the low participation on the MSSA, PED will not produce school or district reports unless certain participation thresholds are met. PED is currently gathering technical advice and weighing the exact threshold to determine if district level reports can be produced. More information on this will be forthcoming by the end of the month.

- PED is hosting a reporting and portal training for DTCs on August 10, 2021; registration is forthcoming.
- Online ISRs are available starting August 16, 2021, through the [Data Interaction \(DI\)](#) portal; printed ISRs arrive in districts around September 13, 2021.
- Family friendly interpretation guides in English, Spanish, and Diné are accessible from the [New Mexico help and support site](#) in mid-September.
- Parents can access ISRs using the [eMetric Parent Portal](#) starting August 23, 2021.
- High School Spanish Reading reports are available through the [Cognia reporting system](#) on August 16, 2021.

SAT

- SAT data is currently available through the College Board Educator Portal.
- DTCS have access to the K-12 Assessment Reporting Help page to learn how to use the K-12 score reporting portal and to view and analyze SAT scores.
- An announcement about upcoming DTC virtual training on understanding and using reports is forthcoming.
