iMSSA MOY Window

The iMSSA middle of year (MOY) window is now open. Assessments are available for scheduling and administration through Friday, January 21, 2022. Cognia Ordering Window

Istation MOY Window

The ISIP middle of year (MOY) window is now open through Monday, January 31, 2022. ISIP assessments are administered automatically the first time a student logs into his or her Istation account each month. An ISIP Reading assessment in English or Spanish (for English learners) is required for all students in grades K-2 during the MOY window. ISIP Math is available statewide but is not a required assessment during the MOY window unless a school is in the K5+ program.

NAEP Updates

Emails were sent to NAEP sampled schools on December 2 explaining how to complete the *Prepare for Assessment* section within MyNAEP. The *Prepare for Assessment* section will be available for School Coordinators to complete within MyNAEP on December 6. Assessment Coordinators will begin contacting School Coordinators to schedule the Pre-Assessment Review Call starting the week of December 6. All School Coordinators will be contacted before winter break. This call will be mainly for the Assessment Coordinator to introduce themselves, schedule the Pre-assessment Review Call for January, and answer any questions. Sampled schools must complete all assessment tasks before conducting the Pre-assessment Review Call.
