The window to order ASR and Spanish Reading SBA testing materials is now open. All materials for these assessments should be ordered for eligible students. Remember that districts do incur a [per-student cost](#) to administer these assessments. Paper materials for the NM-MSSA should also be ordered at this time. College Board Announces SAT Changes

PED has issued a [press release](#) regarding the recent [College Board announcement](#) that the PSAT and SAT will turn completely digital by 2024. Most New Mexico schools already administer a computer-based version of the current SAT in school each spring. However, all SAT and PSAT assessments will transition to a new digital-based format during the 2023-2024 school year. This does not affect testing plans this school year or the next.
