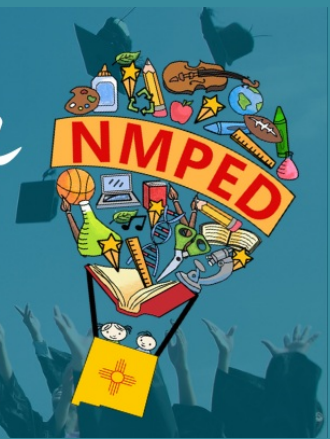

## Data Embargo Memo

Per the [revised memo issued by the PED on June 2](#), districts and charters are reminded that any preliminary summative assessment results available before the PED completes data validation for accountability purposes are considered to be EMBARGOED. During the embargo period, LEAs are prohibited from reporting locally aggregated results to their communities and/or the media.

## Interim Assessment Data Sharing Agreements

Per the [November 12 memo](#) regarding the required use of interim assessments, the PED has begun the process of collecting interim assessment data from districts/charters. Please refer to the information below for guidance on submitting data depending on the interim vendor being used:

- **STAR (Renaissance Learning)**  
Update data-sharing settings and add SSIDs directly to the Renaissance platform using [these instructions](#).

- **MAP (NWEA)**  
The data-sharing agreement will be sent to MAP districts/charters in the coming days. Once received, please email a signed copy to [Adam Rios](#).
- **i-Ready (Curriculum Associates)**  
Sign the [data-sharing agreement](#) and email the signed copy to [Adam Rios](#).
- **iMSSA (Cognia)**  
No action is needed.
- **All Other Interim Assessments**  
Submit evidence of administering an interim to the PED. Evidence can be in the form of aggregated summary level reports as a PDF or Excel document. Evidence should be submitted to the PED via the [Secure Online Assessment Portal](#).
