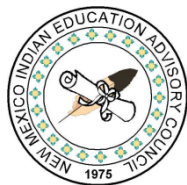

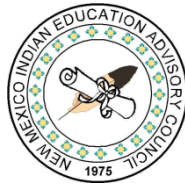

I.	Call to Order (Kim Lanoy-Sandoval, Chair) 4:30 pm
II.	Roll Call IEAC Chair, Kim Lanoy-Sandoval Seated Positions- Present: 8 Absent: 4 Quorum Met
III.	Approval of Agenda Jeremy Oyenque motions to approve minutes with the removal of approving April 19 th minutes & Tracey Cordero 2 nd motion (All approved, zero oppose, agenda has been approved)
IV.	Approval of Meeting Minutes: The Chair will place the approval of meeting minutes on the July 19 th agenda.
V.	Updates from NM Indian Education Department A. Assistant Secretary of Indian Education applications are being excepted. B. Adding a meditation and prayer space to IED architecture plans. IEAC comments: In favor of adding safe, meditation, spaces for the mental health of students. Consider providing guidelines on the terms and wording of the space, such as cultural grounding space and safe spaces. C. Overview of the Yazzie/Martinez Draft Action plan. https://drive.google.com/drive/u/1/folders/1ctOtUf-cBe_IByEw2TReby23ZMTG4bxo IEAC comments: It would be helpful to add data trends in terms of teacher recruitment among each tribe and pueblo. Also, being more clear on the starting points of data and what has been done in the past should be added to the Action Plan. The charts from Rebecca's powerpoint should be included to clearly show data points should be added to the Action Plan. The Action Plan is not specific enough on individual district data to hold them accountable for initiatives laid out in the plan.
VI.	Determine Public Comment IEAC comments: Concerns with accountability at district levels and higher ed following through. The target areas for improvement are only around academic proficiency, where is the qualitative data that promotes a sense of belonging? There is no mention of anti-racist training included in the plan. External factors listed are not external, it is part of a student's identity. In the plan, how do the strategies listed, impact the findings in the lawsuit? What is the remedy or approach for students who



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	<p>fall under multiple categories of being underserved? Equity councils need more authority with the mandates for these groups. The PED turnover keeps the ideas in “planning” mode instead of putting them into action. Public schools are not being held accountable for programming that they receive money for serving Native students. The IEAC appreciates the current leadership at PED trying to get strategies and policies in place. The goals of improvement are ambitious, but a good thing to shoot for. There are 3-4 months to get initiatives proposed for funding through legislation.</p> <p>Kim Lanoy-Sandoval will create a working document for members to add in their public comments to be sent into the PED.</p>
