

Enrollment Cap Amendment Request

Purpose

The *Enrollment Cap Amendment Request* is used to change the number of students the school is approved to serve as described in the charter contract.

An enrollment cap is **not** effective until approved by the PEC.

Enrollment cap requests must be submitted for approval at least two months prior to the school's enrollment period.

Determining Eligibility

Your charter school is eligible to apply to expand (**increase** the enrollment cap) using the *Enrollment Cap Amendment Request*, if the performance of the school meets the following conditions.

In the prior three (3) school years, the school has:

- Received no lower than a "C" letter grade on the state report card (applicable for SY18 and prior) AND Received no lower than the top 75% academic designation on the NM System of School Support and Accountability (applicable for SY19 and forward);
- Received an overall academic tier rating of Tier 1 or Tier 2 on the school's PEC approved Academic Performance Framework, for years in which a PEC Tier Level is available.

AND

- Has not had their Board of Finance revoked within the prior three (3) years.

Schools shall only be eligible to submit an *Enrollment Cap Amendment Request* if the school is on current version of the charter contract (2019). A school under an earlier version of the charter contract may submit this amendment request if it also requests to negotiate its charter contract to the current version.

Submission Window

The *Enrollment Cap Amendment Request* must be submitted at least two months prior to the school's enrollment period for any changes to be effective for the subsequent school year.

The *Enrollment Cap Amendment Request* must be submitted timely so that it may be processed within the timeframe provided in the PEC policy and implemented starting at the beginning of the next fiscal year (consideration at the June meeting is the latest possible consideration for an amendment to become effective in the next fiscal year).

If the fiscal year has started or will start prior to the request being considered by the PEC, an amendment request will be effective only in the subsequent fiscal year, if it is approved.

High schools with an Early College designation from the NM PED are eligible to apply for an enrollment cap increase for second semester. The form and supporting documentation must be submitted no later than 28 days prior to the October PEC meeting and, if approved, the increase will take effect the following January.

PEC Consideration

An administratively complete *Enrollment Cap Amendment Request* submitted by a charter school that meets the eligibility criteria may be placed on the agenda of the next regular PEC meeting if the complete request was received at least 28 days prior to the meeting, or at the subsequent meeting if the complete request was not received at least 28 days prior to the next regularly scheduled meeting.

- A finding that the Charter School is not in compliance with governance reporting and training requirements **will result in a delay** in consideration of the request until the school comes into compliance, or if the school does not come into compliance, until the last meeting within the contractual timeline for a decision from the PEC.
- All performance data (academic, organizational, and financial) for the last three years including any outstanding complaints or investigations will be provided to the PEC for its consideration of the amendment request.

Requests to decrease the enrollment cap may be placed on the consent agenda of a regular PEC meeting. Any request may be removed from the consent agenda either before the scheduled PEC meeting or during the scheduled PEC meeting. If an item is removed from the consent agenda and school representatives are not available, the item will be added for consideration at the next scheduled PEC meeting.

Approval Factors

The PEC's decision to approve or deny an *Enrollment Cap Amendment Request* to increase the enrollment cap will be based on the following considerations, which will be weighed to determine if the applicant has the capacity to implement the requested expansion and ensure continued success in all applicable performance measures:

Has the applicant adequately met its mission;
Is the applicant's academic performance stable or improving;
Has the applicant demonstrated financial stability and good financial management (this will include a review of the financial audits for the past 3 years);
Has the applicant adequately met its organizational performance requirements;
Has the applicant demonstrated community need, support, and satisfaction; and
Has the applicant demonstrated capacity to successfully implement the requested expansion?



ENROLLMENT CAP REQUEST AMENDMENT NARRATIVE

Rationale

Mission Achievement and Success Charter School (MAS) seeks to increase our enrollment cap from 1,140 students to 1,560 students. MAS has continued to outperform both the state and the local district since our initial years of operation in 2012 proving needed and successful options for students in New Mexico. Given both the dearth of high-quality educational options for the local community and our ability to make a difference, we feel not only that we are well-positioned to grow to meet this need, but compelled to do so. More and more families in our community seek a high-quality program supported by wraparound services parents depend on, and we have a plan to meet that demand.

When we opened in 2012, we planned to serve only secondary grades 6-12 offering 120 seats per grade level in each grade, 6-12. As time went on, however, and we saw how many of our students came to us with such deficient academic skills, we realized we needed to reach our students earlier in their academic careers. This is why we pursued authorization to offer elementary instruction as well. At the time, we requested seats to serve 60 students per grade level in grades K-5. The decision to provide only 60 seats per grade level in elementary grades, and 120 seats in each secondary grade was in part because we did not find the demand as high for elementary seats. However, we are now finding the demand for elementary seats far exceeds our enrollment allowance and we are also finding a new challenge that when students transition from 5th grade to 6th grade, up to 50% of the students have been with MAS, while 50% are brand new to our school with significant learning gaps. We have clear academic data to show that starting students early ensures these academic gaps do not exist, therefore, we are seeking to offer 120 seats per grade level through the entire span of K-12 through our enrollment cap increase request.

The details below demonstrate our phase in plan for the additional seats, and a more detailed matrix is included as an attachment to the amendment request.

YALE 2023-2024 School Year – Increase open seats at Yale campus up to 120 per grade. This will NOT require additional FTE's of staffing at the Yale campus because we already run four sections of classrooms, we just do not have them filled to capacity due to the enrollment cap.

Old COORS 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR – Add 9th grade and enroll up to 120 students. Each year after this, we will add up to 120 students in grades 10, 11, and 12 adding one grade level per school year. Furthermore, we will have the ability to enroll up to 120 students in all grades K-9, although at this time most grades have almost that many students and we have still not met the cap because the school as of the 2022-2023 school year only serves grades K-8 while intended to be a K-12 school, therefore, we have plenty of open seats while still enrolling up to 120 per grade at this time.

Recruitment and Hiring

As shared above, we have four sections per grade level with up to 30 students in each section. Therefore, we do not need to hire additional staff to accommodate the cap increase. Instead, we will just need to hire additional staff for our phase in grades, 9-12 at Old Coors. Again, we will be adding one grade level



per year until we reach the 12th grade and will have to hire additional staff to accomplish this, but this was already the plan prior to the cap increase request.

Training

MAS' charter provides robust training to both new and returning teachers. This will remain unchanged even as we grow. Before the school year begins, all staff join in a two-week, full-time training to ground themselves again in the MAS culture of high standards, as well as for team-building purposes. MAS's training, already a core component of our charter is one of the primary reasons for our school's success. We recognize that our student's performance is inextricably linked to the effectiveness of our teachers.

This training continues in our year-round, daily professional development meetings that are led by leadership team members around curriculum needs, grade level needs, and general training needs for educators. We believe our students' impressive outcomes are a testament to our educators' collective effectiveness, bolstered by our team's regular and in-depth trainings that keep our team going further. We intend for every member of our team—both instructional and support staff—to contribute to our mission of high-quality education for our students, and we hire and train to ensure they are prepared for this commitment.

To further explain this, outside the two weeks of professional development provided before the start of each school year referenced above, MAS provides approximately one hour of morning professional development each morning before the start of the school day. This equates to approximately 182 additional professional development hours for our teachers. Furthermore, we have five full professional development days built into our school calendar throughout the school year equating to 40 more hours of professional development. Finally, teachers also have an approximate 90 minute daily preparatory period daily and on average, two of those prep periods each week are spent with the teacher's instructional coach for individualized coaching and training around the teacher's targeted needs.

Student Enrollment Plan

Both during and after a three-month partnership with Bloomwell Group, an established student recruitment consultant, MAS dove into developing a strategic student recruitment plan to continue to meet and improve our student enrollment goals. Our consultant helped us to understand not only how to set recruitment goals and generate leads, but also the best ways to reach families like those in our communities. This intensive planning process led MAS to engage in unprecedented marketing activities, like radio ads, junior poster billboards, digital advertising, and attendance at community events. Additionally, our current students overwhelmingly opt to return for subsequent years—to such an extent that we are often unable to automatically honor the sibling rule and our siblings, particularly in elementary grades, often initially end up on the waitlist. Additionally, since our second year of operation, MAS has never experienced difficulty reaching our yearly enrollment projections.

Furthermore, MAS has engaged with an outside consulting agency with a reputation of supporting high performing nationally recognized charter schools to support us in ensuring enrollment targets are met with our increased growth plan.



Resources for Implementation

Because we are adding seats instead of grades, we have all the curriculum and teacher training materials we need. While we will need to increase the quantity of those instructional materials, like textbooks, and provide more desks for our students, we are confident that our cash balances are sufficient to cover any delay in funding through the SEG. This is in addition to private grant funding and donations that MAS has secured. Additionally, we have achieved enough of an economy of scale through our previous years' growth that we can provide for this proposed increase in seats.

Yale Campus

The Yale facility presently has the occupancy load required to hold the enrollment cap increase. See Certificate of Occupancy for Yale campus.

Old Coors Campus

The Old Coors facility is presently under construction. Presently MAS Charter School Old Coors Campus is 100% a portable campus. At the start of the 2022-2023 school year, MAS will take occupancy of Phase I of our construction and the remaining classrooms will be in portables as Phase II of construction is completed. The Old Coors property is 16 acres in totality and construction will be completed in two phases for cost and timing, again, with Phase I completing in July of 2022. Attached is the Portable Phasing and Classroom Location document to demonstrate the phase in plan of portables while Phase II construction is being completed.

With that said, the following statements serve as an assurance for the Old Coors property that MAS Charter School will not occupy space until the school possesses a Certificate of Occupancy and provides the same to the PEC. Furthermore, MAS will not occupy space for the Old Coors property until the school possesses a NMCI letter from the PSFA and provides the same to the PEC. Additionally, MAS Charter School assures that MAS Charter School will not occupy any space that does not have sufficient capacity load to sustain the enrollment requested and we will provide documentation of the capacity load to the PEC. Finally, MAS provides assurance that for the Old Coors property, we will not occupy any space that does not meet the ownership and leasing requirements of Section 22-8B-4.2 NMSA 1978.


