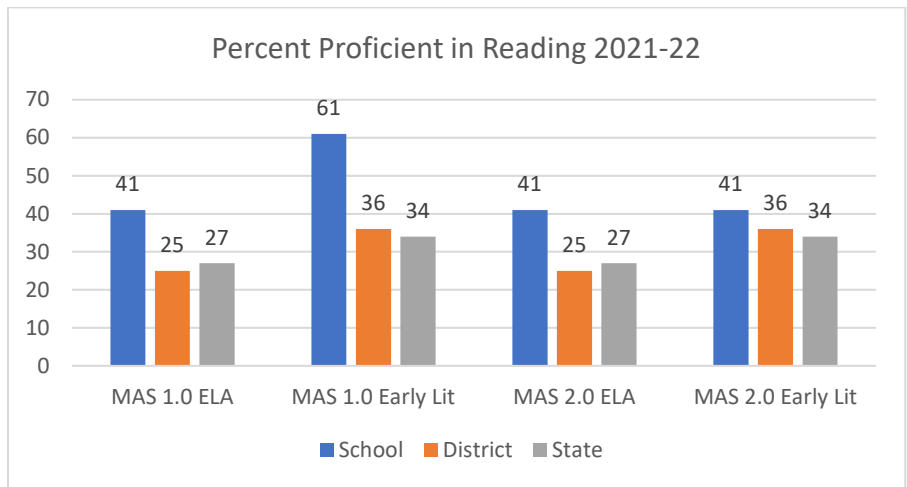
Mission Achievement and Success (MAS) Charter School requests PEC approval to increase the enrollment cap for its campus at 1718 Yale Blvd. from 1140 to 1560. The enrollment cap for the school’s second campus on Old Coors Rd. will remain 1140 as that campus is adding a grade a year and has not reached its cap.

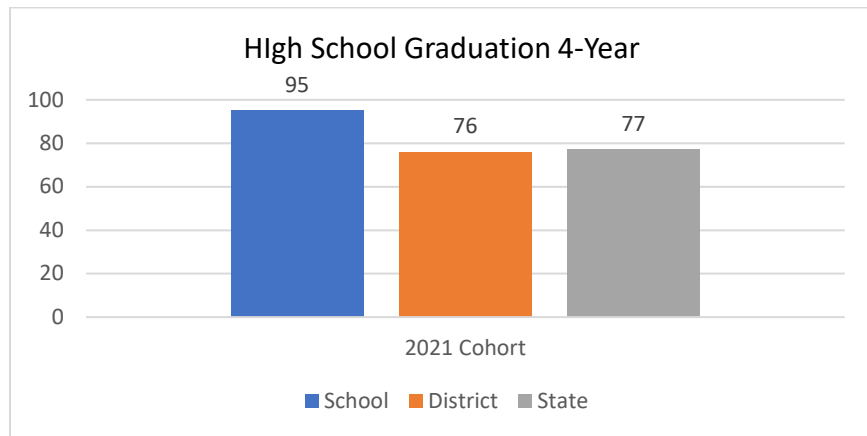
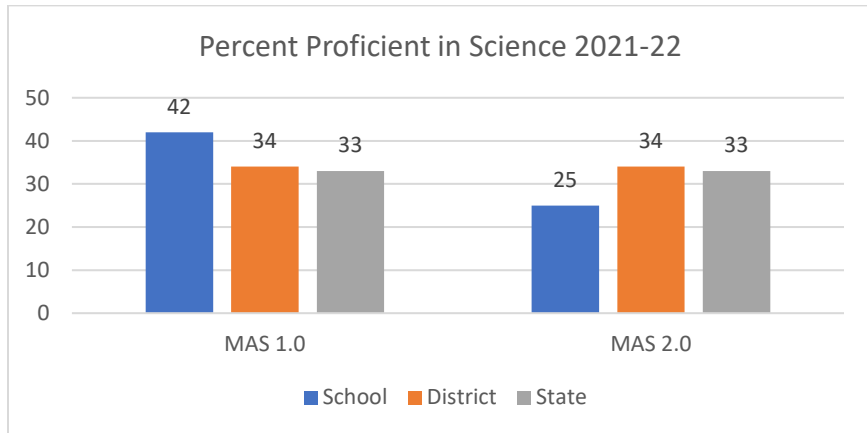
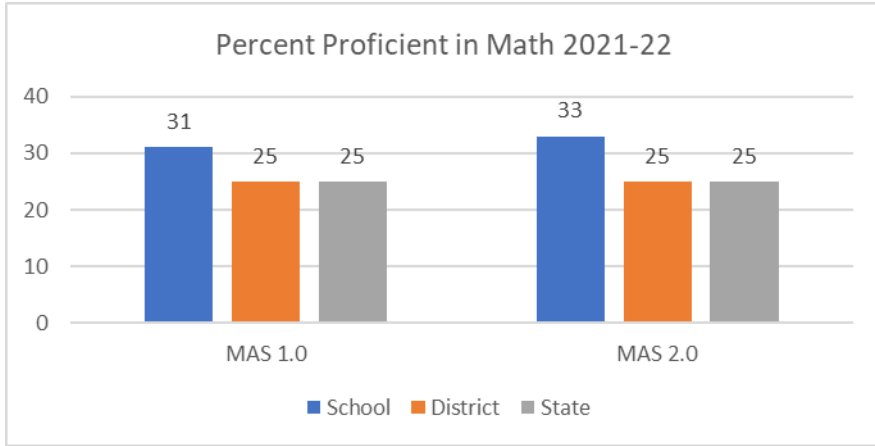
The proposed change would not require additional teaching staff or curriculum resources. The school currently has four sections in each grade and could accommodate 30 students per grade, for a total of 1560 students in each grade from Kindergarten to grade 12.

Under the current enrollment cap of 1140, if students are distributed evenly across grades and four classrooms per grade, the school can accommodate only 21.9 students per classroom. The Yale campus has a waiting list for all grades, and the school has provided signatures to show community support for the change.

The E-Occupancy certificate for the Yale campus allows a maximum of 1794.

MAS has met the requirements in the amendment request policy with the exception of organizational performance requirements, which CSD can verify up through 2020-21, but because the school renewed in 2022, there was no annual monitoring or annual report for 2021-22. Performance framework ratings, including for financial indicators, demonstrate that the school has adequately met its organizational performance requirements and is in good financial standing for the prior years. The school’s 2021-22 proficiencies and 2021 graduation rate exceed the district and state average, as shown in charts below., as shown in chart below.





MAS renewed its charter in 2022 and therefore does not have performance framework ratings for the 2021-22 school year.
