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Charter Schools Division Final Renewal Recommendation for Altura Preparatory School December 1, 2022

The Charter Schools Division (CSD) of the New Mexico Public Education Department recommends to the Public Education Commission that Altura Preparatory School be **renewed** for a term of five years with no conditions.

The school has not violated any of the terms of New Mexico Statutes Annotated (NMSA) 1979, Section 22-8B-12 K, the educational program is being implemented with fidelity, and the school outperforms both district and state in reading, math, and science proficiencies.

The <u>preliminary analysis</u> contained an error in science proficiency reporting: the school did not serve grade 5 that year and there should have been no data. The percentage of proficient students in science for 2021-22 is 86%, not 47% as reported in the preliminary analysis.

All renewal ratings and annual ratings remain the same despite the <u>response</u> to the preliminary analysis. Although the CSD makes no recommendations for conditions, the CSD appreciates that the school wholeheartedly believes that there remains work to be done to ensure that the school continues to deliver on our promise of providing all students, regardless of background, with an education that prepares them academically and personally for success beyond fifth grade. And the school asserts that for 2022-23 and 2023-24, the school [will] continue to refine the approach to recruitment and enrollment, particularly with respect to attempting to enroll economically disadvantaged students, English Language Learners, and students with disabilities.
