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Charter Schools Division Final Renewal Recommendation for New Mexico Connections Academy December 1, 2022

The Charter Schools Division (CSD) of the New Mexico Public Education Department recommends to the Public Education Commission that New Mexico Connections Academy be renewed for a term of five years with a condition to study the cause of the low graduation rate and develop a plan for improving graduation outcomes.

The school has not violated any of the terms of New Mexico Statutes Annotated (NMSA) 1979, Section 22-8B-12 K. NMCA's Educational Program, as delineated in the contract, is being implemented with fidelity with the exception of the school-within-a-school model, as discussed in the Preliminary Renewal Analysis.

Although the school earned a rating of **Failing to Demonstrate Progress** for 1.a. Student Outcomes, the school does show growth from 2018-19 levels in reading, math, and science, with growth in reading (19% to 38%) and math are (7% to 23%) significant. 2021-22 proficiencies are slightly above the state average for reading and science, slightly below for math. Graduation rates are significantly below the state average for all years of the contract. CSD appreciates that the school acknowledges the need for improvement in the <u>response to the preliminary renewal analysis</u>, "NMCA is not satisfied with the current graduation rates and, as was articulated both in the school's renewal application and at the renewal site visit, the school has taken deliberate actions to improve graduation success for those students who are working to complete the necessary graduation requirements."

In the preliminary analysis, CSD reported that the school had not yet submitted mission goal data for year 4. The CSD revised this portion of the report to reflect that in year 4, the school exceeded its mission goal for grades 4-8 and met it for grades 9-12. This did not change the school's rating of **Meets the Standard** for 1.b. Mission-Specific Goals.
