This is a program that encourages prosocial behavior and is not related to academic performance. Staff gives bear bucks to students and students choose what to buy from the school store on a monthly basis. Andrea and Joyce Hodges, school counselor, are working on this initiative. They are waiting on items to be delivered and plan on opening store in the next month.
- b. Director's Report Carissa Cantrell
  - New student data: 193 new students total. Word of mouth has allowed this growth.
  - Maintenance and facilities: Current vendor of HVAC is not meeting our needs. Our in-house maintenance employee is now completing quarterly maintenance. We are looking at vendors for our copy machines and printers. New Landscape company. New alarm company to update system has started.
  - Employee updates:
    - Vacancies: We still need Occupational Therapist and Social Worker. CES is filling these positions.
    - New employee- Ada Gallegos is our new registrar and front desk receptionist
    - Diana Cordova will move to a contractor role and support the business office
  - Assessment data: Individual student and parent data has been shipped. Results will be shared in the newsletter this week for families. We are above the state average but we will continue to improve. Our DTC meets with staff to discuss data, interventions are provided to address gaps based on student need.
  - Congratulations to Mrs. Sarah McMaster who received the VOYA grant for reading in her classroom.
  - First round of teacher walkthroughs. No longer 'grading' teachers but it allows for a conversation and feedback. Focus was classroom management, safe learning environment, expectation, routines, and procedures. Elements are increased each time. Walkthroughs are almost complete. All staff professional development plans are due next week.
  - PTO movie night is next week. 400 people have purchased tickets.
  - Carissa's PDP- Draft currently includes community outreach, collaboration to grow enrollment, expand facilities, and increase name recognition through media outlets. She will share template with council
  - Charter renewal: September 29th. Same format that was done in Spring. Interviews with groups of teachers, students, parents, board members. CSD team can recommend renewal by November. PEC will make decision in December.
