BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: House Bill 512 (HB512) amends several sections of Article 13-6 NMSA 1978, [Sale of Public Property](#), to add counties to the list of entities, like school districts and state educational

institutions, that are exempt from particular sale-of-public-property requirements and that are able to receive donations of public property.

The bill does not provide an effective date. Laws go into effect 90 days after the adjournment of the Legislature enacting them, unless a later date is specified. If enacted, this bill would become effective June 16, 2023.
