Hello, all -

Happy Friday Eve! Our team submitted a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, to be published May 16, for the following rules:

- 1. 6.2.9 NMAC, Public Education Commission State Charter School Procedures (New)
- 2. 6.2.8 NMAC, Operational Bylaws of the Professional Practices and Standards Council (Repeal, Replace)
- 3. <u>6.63.8 NMAC, Licensure in Athletic Coaching, 7-12</u> (Repeal, Replace)
- 4. 6.29.5 NMAC, English Language Development Instruction Requirements (Amendment)
- 5. 6.32.2 NMAC. Language Acquisition in the Home or Heritage Language (Amendment)

As promised, here are next steps. As you can see on the attached Notice...

- The <u>public comment period will begin May 16 and will end at 5pm on June 21</u>. The Notice provides information on how to obtain copies of the rule and how to submit feedback. Note that all feedback received <u>after</u> the comment period will be considered late and will not be part of the rule record.
- The <u>public hearing will be June 21, 1:30pm -2:30pm, in Mabry Hall</u>. The public hearing will be for all five of the proposed rules. Those providing feedback at the hearing will have three minutes to speak.
- Policy staff will also hold, on a date before the public hearing, an informal presentation session about the proposed rulemaking for tribal directors and leaders. We will reach out to program ASAP to determine a date and time. This will be held virtually.
- The Policy team will compile all of the feedback that is submitted within the public comment period and post it on our Proposed Rules page.
- The Policy team will work with program to review and consider the feedback. The feedback will help inform if or how the proposed rule changes before it is adopted.
- Assuming the changes do not require significant time to review, the rules can be adopted as early as July 7, and may be effective as early s July 18 (unless program specifically asked that the effective date be at a later date).
