Educated adults are healthier individuals, and crime rates decrease as the population becomes more educated. According to the National Adult Literacy Survey, 70% of all incarcerated adults cannot read at a fourth-grade level, "meaning they lack the reading skills to navigate many everyday tasks or hold down anything but lower paying jobs."

Education assists in improving adult's mental well-being. "An extra year of education led to a lower likelihood of reporting any symptoms related to depression (11.3%) and anxiety (9.8%). More educated people also suffered less severe symptoms – depression (6.1%) and anxiety (5.6%). These protective effects are higher among women and rural residents."

WHAT WE DO



ENGLISH IS NOT THEIR PRIMARY LANGUAGE. WEEKLY,
TWO-HOUR, ONE-TO-ONE SESSIONS HELP LEARNERS
ACQUIRE BEGINNING ENGLISH VOCABULARY AND
CONVERSATION AS WELL AS BASIC READING AND
WRITING INSTRUCTION.




OUR VOLUNTEER TUTORS ASSIST ENGLISH SPEAKING ADULT LEARNERS TO RAISE THEIR READING AND WRITING LEVELS IN PRIVATE, TWO HOURS SESSIONS ONCE A WEEK. THE WEEKLY TUTORING SESSIONS ARE ARRANGED ACCORDING TO THE STUDENT'S WORK AND PERSONAL SCHEDULE.

MATH AND FINANCIAL LITERACY
TUTORS WILL ASSIST STUDENTS WITH BASIC MATH,
INTERMEDIATE MATH AND FINANCIAL LITERACY
SKILLS. STUDENTS MAY ALSO ATTEND FINANCIAL
LITERACY ONLINE. THIS COURSE IS DESIGNED TO
ENHANCE THE STUDENT'S MATH SKILLS IN DAY TO DAY
SITUATIONS AND ANSWER BASIC FINANCIAL
QUESTIONS.









OTHER TUTORING AND CLASSES OFFERED:

COMPUTER LITERACY
TUTORS INSTRUCT THEIR ADULT LEARNER IN BASIC
COMPUTER USE. IN MODULES DEVELOPED BY GCF
GLOBAL, STUDENTS LEARN HOW TO USE THE
INTERNET, SET UP AN EMAIL ACCOUNT, SEND AN EMAIL
WITH ATTACHMENTS, APPLY FOR JOBS AND OTHER
INTRODUCTORY COMPUTER USES.



PRE-HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY PREP A ONE-TO-ONE TUTOR WILL INSTRUCT ADULT LEARNERS ONE SUBJECT AT A TIME TO BECOME PREPARED TO TAKE THE HISET. THERE ARE 5 SECTIONS ON THE HISET EXAM. AT INTAKE, A PRETEST WILL BE GIVEN TO THE ADULT LEARNER. STUDENTS AND THEIR TUTORS FOCUS ON AREAS THE STUDENT TESTED AT OR BELOW A HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL.





ALL TUTORS MUST COMPLETE AT LEAST 10 HOURS OF TRAINING AND ATTEND LEARNER FOCUSED WORKSHOPS TO TEACH AT READWEST





READWEST SERVES ADULTS 17 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER. CLASSES ARE FREE AND IT'S FREE TO SIGN UP.

STEP 3: THE PROGRAM COORDINATOR WILL PAIR STUDENTS TO A TUTOR AND/OR CLASS




