


Environmental Racism

Environmental policies, practices, or directives that differentially affect or disadvantage individuals, groups, or communities based on race and color (whether intentionally or unintentionally).

Superfund Site

In the US, toxic superfund sites are contaminated with hazardous chemicals, often due to industrial activity. They are identified and barricaded for people's safety but many are dangerously close to communities. Further, hundreds are exposed to natural disasters - notably wildfires and floods - and the likelihood of chemical dispersion via these events is increasing with climate change.

We are building community partnerships. Our school collaborates with two community farms to research and teach students about the land that our school occupies.





- Garden bed calculations for length and width of beds
- Calculate the volume to understand how much soil will need to be used.

Humanities
