Under the Organizational Performance Framework Indicator 3C. a Charter School must demonstrate, and when requested, provide evidence that "The school creates a safe environment and is in compliance with the charter contract, federal and state statutes and rules, and PED guidelines unless waivers preserving charter autonomy are in place." This Annual Compliance Requirements document represents a list of evidence and data sources the Charter Schools Division (CSD) may monitor, in partnership with other PED Bureaus to assess a school's progress with standards within the Organizational Performance Framework. It is also a tool to support schools with self-monitoring. Evidence of compliance must be demonstrated and made available for inspection by the deadline established by the respective PED bureau or by the CSD annual site visit date, whichever occurs earliest.
