

# DUTIES OF THE LOCAL HOMELESS LIAISON



#### Enrollment

Ensuring the identification and school enrollment of students experiencing homelessness

# Support

Connecting families experiencing homelessness to early childhood services.

Supporting the informed engagement of parents. Supporting unaccompanied homeless youths

#### Awareness

Disseminating public notice of McKinney-Vento rights and services. Providing professional development to school personnel.

# Referring

Referring families/unaccompanied youth experiencing homelessness to outside agencies (housing, health and mental health care, food, public benefits, employment, etc.). Many of them will likely need hands-on assistance., as they are in crisis.
