School response:

Raices del Saber Xinachtli Community School has seen steady growth through their first contract year. The school's operation budget grew from \$302,490.90 in year 1 to \$,345,165.20 in year 4, which is almost 4 and a half times the first years. The school's growth has been proportional to their size with student growth going from 61 students in the first year to 124 students at the end of the fourth year. The schools SEG funding has been a little lagged, due to SEG being calculated on their 40, 80 and 120-day numbers in the previous year and the continuing growth trend being seen. The school is still in its years of growth and has not hit its top expectancy for enrollment and therefore, the calculation are short and have been adjusted by NMPED mid-year. Raices' staff and students have been the forefront of the school focus and expenditures reflect this. The school had received several different grants to help ensure adequate staffing, but the school is focused on ensuring all key roles are being funded through the operational budget and not to rely on additional sources for their key employees.
