



# All Valid Tests (AVT)

- All Valid Tests (AVT) includes all test scores and test attempts/rostering for DLM, SBA, SAT, MSSA/ASR end-of-year summative testing
- AVT also includes grades K-2 iStation end-of-year (EOY) highest score from assessments completed during the EOY testing window (April 1 – May 31)
  - For the Accountability Model proficiency and test participation analyses, iStation only includes K-2 scores from schools that EXCLUSIVELY enroll grades preK-2
- An Accountability Model variable (AccountabilityModel) indicates whether the record is included in accountability model analysis for NM VISTAS and District/State Report Cards
  - If the Accountability Model value is 0, the record is excluded from proficiency and test participation calculations for reasons listed in the Exclude from Accountability Reason (ExclAccoutabilityReason) variable
  - Reasons for exclusion are described on separate slides

#### **Data Sources**

- <u>All Valid Enrollments (AVE)</u>: File created by REA from enrollment snapshots, attendance data, and Title 1 and CYFD data for students identified as migrants or in foster care
- <u>Stage 1 Vendor-provided Assessment files</u>: Data from vendors for DLM, SBA, SAT, and MSSA/ASR end-of-year summative testing, and iStation formative testing from the EOY testing window
- <u>Assessment Bureau Approved Waivers/Invalidations</u>: Waivers and test invalidations approved by the Assessment Bureau including
  - Medical waivers
  - English Learner (EL) waivers for students taking a test in Spanish
  - Out-of-grade testing waivers
  - Test invalidations

## Definitions and Coding of Various Variables

- Eligible / Days Enrolled/ Accountable Entity / (Test) Participation
  - See AVE Guide for explanations
- SameSchool\_AccountabilityModel: Accountable school and Test Participation school are the same (1) or different (0)
- Accountability Model (0, 1): Calculated based on exclusions, described subsequently
- Exclusion from Accountability Model Reason: All reasons for exclusion are concatenated, including test from which excluded
- Proficient: Calculated using SS or PL
- Test Language: Based on test or language indicator in vendor-provided test file
- Invalidated: Calculated based on indicator provided in test file or Assessment Bureau's list of approved invalidated/irregular tests

10.FRL	Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch		
11.NotFRL	Students who do not qualify for FRL		
12.DirCert	Students with direct certification for SNAP or related benefits		
13.NotDirCert	Students not certified to receive SNAP or related benefits		
14.SwD	Students with disabilities		
15.NotSwD	Students without disabilities		
16.EL	English Learners		
17.NotEL	Students not identified as English Learners		
18.Migrant	Migrant students; data for this variable were obtained through PED Title 1 Bureau (not STARS)

21.Foster	Students with foster placement; data for this variable were obtained through PED (not STARS)

# Exclusions from Accountability Model

- Student ID is not included in AVE file (local school ID used, homeschooled student, etc.)
   and Assessment Bureau was unable to locate in STARS
- No district/school included for case in vendor-provided test file and Assessment Bureau was unable to locate in STARS for DLM, SBA, SAT, MSSA/ASR or using domain for iStation
- Accountable school (enrolled at least 90 days) as well as schools at 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> reporting periods not all the same
- Foreign exchange student
- Medical waiver
- Invalid test waiver or invalid test indicator in vendor-provided test file
- Uptested without out-of-grade waiver
- Downtested (Enrolled Grade > Tested Grade)
- Tested with enrolled grade = 12
- Duplicate test record within the same assessment; the accountability model retains the highest proficiency level test Investing for tomorrow, delivering today.

#### **EL Waiver and iStation Exclusions**

- EL Waivers and Tests Taken in Spanish
  - Records with Years in US Schools = 0, 1, or 2 do not need an EL waiver to take an assessment in Spanish and were included in the accountability model (unless excluded for other reasons)
  - Records with Years in US Schools = 3 or 4 are required to have an approved EL waiver to take an assessment in Spanish. They were excluded from the accountability model if no Assessment Bureau approved waiver
  - Records with Years in US schools = 5 or with missing Years in US Schools who took an assessment in Spanish were excluded from the accountability model
- iStation EOY scores are used ONLY for schools that exclusively enroll kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> and/or 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students (i.e., no grades above 2<sup>nd</sup>)

#### Multiple Assessments Exclusions

- If a student completed multiple assessments and those assessments were not excluded for other reasons, the following order of selection rules were applied such that each student had one remaining valid test score per subject/subtest (ELA, Math, Science), regardless of proficiency level:
  - 1. DLM and Alternate = 1
  - 2. SBA
  - 3. SAT
  - 4. MSSA/ASR
  - 5. iStation (K-2 only, and only for schools enrolling only preK-2 grades)
  - 6. DLM and Alternate = 0

## Proficiency Levels

- DLM: The vendor-provided file includes a proficiency level, Performance\_Level
  - Performance\_Level = 9 indicates an invalidated or incomplete test and is excluded
- SBA: The vendor-provided file includes a proficiency level,
   ReadPerformanceLevel
- SAT: The vendor-provided file includes scaled scores, recoded into proficiency levels per <u>SAT-Performance-Levels.pdf</u> (state.nm.us)
- MSSA/ASR: The vendor-provided file includes a proficiency level, AchLevel

SAT Level	ELA	Math
Level 1	200 - 410	200 - 410
Level 2	420 - 470	420 - 520
Level 3	480 - 620	530 - 640
Level 4	630 - 800	650 - 800

iStation: The vendor-provided file includes a proficiency level, Overall\_LEVEL;
 the highest score achieved during the EOY window is retained

# Proficient Indicator (0, 1)

- DLM: If the Proficiency Level Indicator Performance\_Level is 3 or greater,
   Proficient = Yes (1)
- SBA: If the Proficiency Level is **3 or greater**, Proficient = Yes (1)
- SAT:
  - ELA: If ELA Scaled Score is greater than or equal to 480, Proficient = Yes (1)
  - Math: If Math Scaled Score is greater than or equal to 530, Proficient = Yes (1)
- MSSA/ASR: If the Proficiency Level is 3 or greater, Proficient = Yes (1)
- iStation: If the Proficiency Level is 4 or greater, Proficient = Yes (1)
