A school district, a state-chartered charter school, or locally chartered charter school that meets at least one of the following criteria must complete the following: *Needs Assessment, Systemic Framework, and Accountability Tool as of SY2020-2021*:

1. serves at least 175 American Indian or Alaska Native students and is located wholly or partially on tribal land; or
2. identifies at least ten percent of its overall student population as American Indian or Alaska Native and is located wholly or partially on tribal land; or
3. identifies at least 45 percent of its overall student population as American Indian or Alaska Native.
