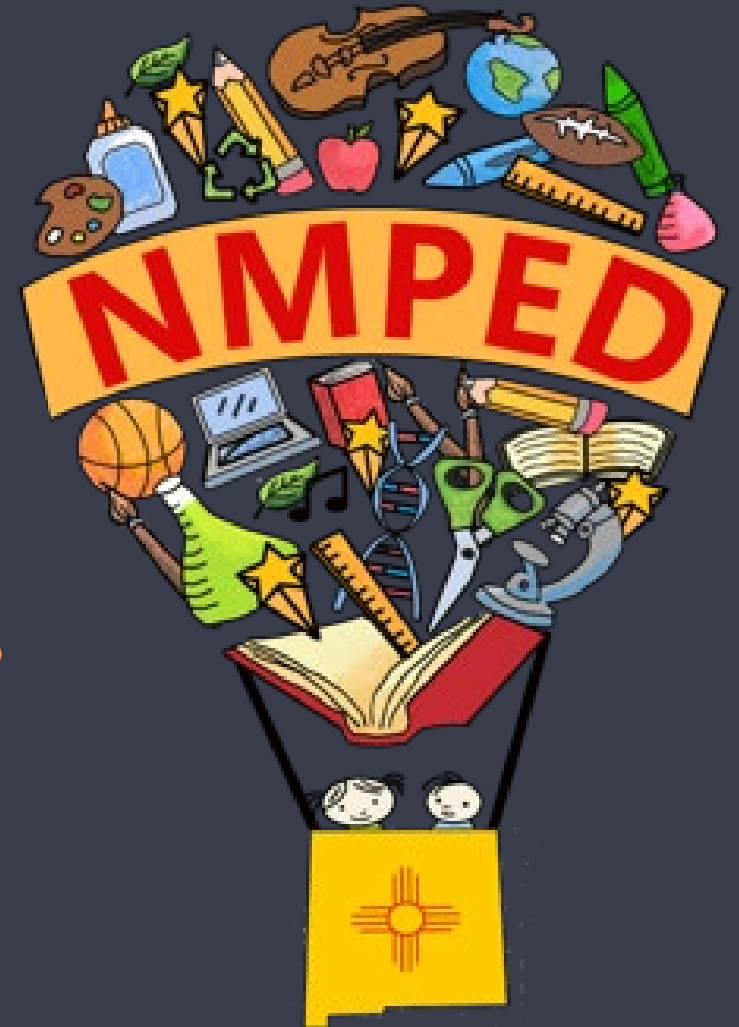

# Data Sources

- 2021-22 Proficiency for ELA and Math
- 2022-23 Proficiency for ELA and Math
- For the All Students groups, ELA and Math proficiencies were attenuated for test participation if test participation rates were less than 95%

# Academic Growth Methodology

- In prior years, academic growth calculations were based on student-level proficiencies from 2 years prior
  - Two years prior in 2020-21, New Mexico's test participation rate was only 10%, with many schools as low as 5%
  - No summative tests were administered in 2019-20—three years prior
- Given the non-representative group of students assessed in 2020-21 and lack of prior years data, academic growth calculations for VISTAS/DSRC 2022-23 only include 2021-22 and 2022-23 summative scores
- Additionally, calculations are based on the school/district level rather than the student level
- In 2023-24, with three years of “back to normal” assessment data, PED will return to growth modeling as done previously

# Academic Growth Calculations

Academic Growth = 2022-23 Proficiency - 2021-22 Proficiency

To ensure an apples to apples comparison, 2021-22 proficiencies were recalculated using the same business rules applied in 2022-23:

- EL Waiver rules
- Accountable school (enrolled more than 90 days) and schools at 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> reporting periods are all the same
