## Reviewer Feedback on Notice of Intent

(provided at the request of the Public Education Commission)

The New Mexico Charter School Act, NMSA 22-8B-1 *et.seq* requires any group seeking to become a state charter school to provide a notice to the Public Education Commission ("PEC") and the school district in which the charter school is proposed to be located. The Notice of Intent ("NOI") requires all applicants to identify the mission, outline of the educational program, founding team members demonstrating diverse and necessary capabilities to execute its plan successfully and a description of the community need and support for the school.

In order to promote strong applications that comply with the statutory requirements, the PEC has asked a staff member with a strong charter background to provide feedback on submitted Notices of Intent. In addition, the Charter Schools Division will provide training opportunities and support related to submittal of the full new school application. This evaluation is for support only and will not be utilized as part of the evaluation of the full application. The document neither represents the opinion of the PEC or any individual commissioner nor indicate that the application will be approved once submitted. The document is for guidance only.

The reviewer is looking at the NOI for the following:

A strong NOI indicates that the team submitting the NOI is on track to the development of a high-quality charter school application. A strong response addresses elements in most areas and strengths outweigh weaknesses. Weaknesses, if present, are minor and unlikely to adversely impact the school's ability to develop and operate successfully.
