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2022-23 Accountability Measures Overview

The framework for accountability and support recognizes that school performance should be assessed in five overarching categories aligned to Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requirements for meaningfully differentiating schools: 1) academic achievement, 2) academic progress, 3) English language proficiency, 4) indicators of school quality that contribute to college and career readiness, and 5) graduation rate. Each indicator is scored based on student outcomes in that area.

Overall scores, on a scale of 0-55 for K-2 schools and a scale of 1-100 for elementary, middle, and high schools, represent an aggregate of indicator outcomes, based on the scoring structure in the table below. If a school does not have data for an indicator (i.e., the measure is not scored) the points for that indicator are proportionally distributed to other indicators. The indicators below are included in a school's overall NM Vistas points calculations based on the school's grade configuration, with three options: K-2 only schools; elementary/middle schools; and high schools.
