VI. Principal Report

a. 670 enrollment. 51% Native American. Tribal consultation will take place on Friday. Preschool application pending approval. Hillsdale hosted 5 students. Hillsdale site visit occurred- have not received follow up yet. NWEA results show increase growth from 26th to 46th in Math from 2022 to 2024. ELA also increased from 34th to 52nd achievement. Around 40th is national average. PSAT taken for the first time at our school- our entire 10th grade take it. New Mexico requires 11th graders to take it. 42% of our students exceeded ERW benchmark and 14% have exceeded Math benchmark. Students featured on front cover of Independent for Project Venture receiving 2 million in funds. 182 kids on waiting list.

VII. Finance Report – Budget Report

a. Policies and procedures were emailed. Reauthorizing since no changes have occurred. Budget best practices: sustainable, compliant, and has public input (open meeting). FY 25 changes. Unit value went up by 3.22%. At risk multipliers decreased 0.031 which reduces SEG for Hozho by \$134k- everyone's went down this year not just Hozho. Extended calendar increases funding-\$1,539,511.76 for Hozho. Funding based on membership and calendar. Our calendar will look very similar to FY24. Charter school division paid for by 2% of schools SEG funding. Salaries increase 3%. NMPSIA (medical expenses and premiums) rates have increased 15% and risk insurance has increased 40% for Hozho because of buses, building liability, and sports. Budget is based on conservative estimate of enrollment being 755 students. Kept salary schedule from past 2 years but returning teachers will get increase of 3%. ERB pension stayed flat. Federal funding decreased due to ESSER funds (covid) ending. Still waiting on transportation funding estimate. Lease assistance will go up because enrollment increase. 58% of budget are salary and benefits. Projected revenue \$15.7 million- largest is SEG (68%), impact aid could increase more since have increased amount of students that would qualify. Athletic salaries \$204,500. NMPSIA is an estimate because premiums are increasing so
