- 1) Important Note: Required Emergency Drills- per NMAC-See Safe School Plan Assurance FY 24-25
  It is recommended that you schedule all Emergency Drills for the year within the first week of school and add them to your school calendar in advance to enable you to meet the statutory requirements. Schools are required to invite the responding jurisdiction Fire Department if one is maintained in your jurisdiction, however they are not required to attend.
- 2) Training records, rosters, and certificates should be maintained at the district/school levels. Many of these documents will be required to be uploaded with your plans. (IC 100, AED/CPR)
