Indicators of Success Policy

Purpose: To ensure all Public Education Commission (PEC)-authorized schools' governing bodies conduct an annual self-assessment using the *Indicators of Success* tool. The questions address areas that contribute to a healthy, high-functioning and sustainable school as they relate to Leadership, Culture, Talent, Instruction, Finance and Governance.

Although the information is provided to CSD via the online tool, the information will be kept confidential and at no time shall the PEC review the assessment results of an individual school's submission. The PEC may review aggregated information once all schools have submitted the forms, with CSD, to determine technical assistance needs for state charter schools as a whole. ~~The CSD may review an individual school's results to help prioritize and support a school in addressing areas of distress.~~

The self-assessment itself will not be rated by CSD, nor be addressed during site visits and results will not be included in school's record of performance, but timeliness of submission will be part of Indicator 3.c Compliance in the Performance Framework.

Submission Deadline: Confirmation must be received within 90 calendar days of the beginning of each school year that the board placed a discussion of the Indicators of Success on its agenda and that the board chair (not the head administrator) submitted to the Charter Schools Division (CSD) the results of the assessment.

The school must:

- Provide a copy of the Governing Board Minutes demonstrating action was taken to finalize the assessment.
- Complete the assessment (one assessment per school) in the Google Form link, provided by CSD for that fiscal year, no later than September 1 of each year.
