CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES QUESTIONNAIRE (CHEQ) 2024-25

BUREAU

CHEQ is a survey completed by parents/caregivers early in the kindergarten school year. The CHEQ gathers information on children's experiences prior to kindergarten that are important to their healthy development and well-being.

Who completes the CHEQ in 2024–2025?

The CHEQ is completed by the parent/guardian. For each kindergartner student, only one parent/guardian should complete the survey.

What does the instrument measure?

The CHEQ Survey collects information about children's healthy development and well-being, in five domains including questions about their interactions with others, activities at home and in the community, and access to and use of community resources and services. Five Domains of CHEQ

- Health and Well-Being
- Language and Cognition
- Social and Emotional Well-being
- Early Learning and Care
- Community & Context

When is the instrument completed?

CHEQ is completed during SY 2024–2025 during the fall around the time of parent-teacher conferences.

How is the instrument completed?

Designated district coordinators or lead teachers will provide a letter to parents/caregivers that includes a QR code and a URL link to the CHEQ online survey. Parents/guardians can complete the survey during a designated time at school or from home at their convenience. The survey takes approximately 20 minutes to complete.

How are CHEQ results used?

CHEQ summary results are reported for the school and community to help teachers, school administrators, and community partners improve targeted supports for children and families.

Where can I access training and more information?

The district EDI coordinator will be the primary contact within each district/charter for the CHEQ parent survey. They will receive training and materials to share needed information with principals and teachers. Materials are posted on the <u>PED's EDI/CHEQ website</u> and training dates are <u>here</u>.
