

You might have students who are eligible for additional resources and services from Title I, Part C, the Migrant Education Program.

Who is eligible?

Students who have relocated to your district or charter school within the last three years are eligible if their parent or guardian works as an agricultural farmworker or fisher. Additionally, students or youth are eligible if they are employed as agricultural farmworkers themselves.

Why you should provide a referral

Title I, Part C is a supplemental program aimed at supporting highly mobile (migratory) students or youth by addressing and reducing barriers to their academic success.
