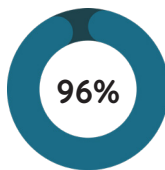
P2C Math is available to ALL New Mexico schools at no cost thanks to a federal grant.



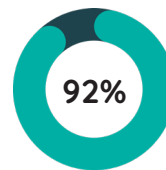
Engaging Math Curriculum

The question asked in every math classroom year after year is, *"When will I ever need to know this in the real world?"*

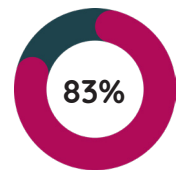
