

### **Title I Comparability Requirement**

ESEA, as amended, section 1118(c)...a local educational agency may receive funds under this part only if State and local funds will be used in schools served under this part to provide services that, taken as a whole, are at least comparable to services in schools that are not receiving funds under this part.

- Submission window opens October 7, 2024.
- Due December 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
- Form 3A is built into SharePoint this year (new).
- Every district and state charter school completes Form 3A.
- Form 3B is required for some districts or state charter schools.

### **General Overview**

### What is Comparability?

- Title I fiscal requirement intended to ensure that Title I schools are provided state and local educational resources that are equitable or comparable to those received by schools not participating in Title I.
- Title I schools are compared against non-Title I schools in terms of student/teacher ratios or per pupil expenditures. In addition, they are compared to other Title I schools within the district.
- Comparability was codified into law in 1970 in response to early actions by school districts that either shifted state funds away from Title I schools or failed to provide comparable services to Title I schools.

### 1. Form 3A

Local Education Agencies (LEA) applying for grants under Title I are required to assure that State and local funds will be used to provide services in schools receiving Title I funds which are at least comparable to services being provided in schools which are not receiving Title I funds. They must further assure that, if all schools are receiving Title I funds, State and local funds must be used to provide services which are comparable in all schools. Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), as amended, section 1118(c) provides the criteria for determinations of the comparability of State and locally-funded services of schools funded under Title I. By completing this form, a local educational agency will know which groups of schools, if any, must be included on the attached "Detailed School Data" form (3b). Please note that if one of their schools has less than 100 students, the school does not need to be included in the "Detailed School Data" form (3b).

## Form 3A (Continued)

- Grade spans are identified.
  - i.e., K-6, 7-8, 9-12, K-8, etc.
- Schools can be separated into size categories, smaller and larger
- LEAs add the number of schools they have and include their enrollment numbers based on the 40-day enrollment report.
- If there are multiple schools within the same grade span and size category, LEAs will show the enrollment range of those schools.

Example:

District Z has 4 small elementary schools with the following enrollment counts; 105, 127,150,156.

In Comparability report 3A, they would list the range of their small elementary schools: 105-156.

### Smaller Schools vs Larger Schools Within a Grade Span

- Schools within a single grade span must be compared to other schools with similar enrollment numbers and not to schools that are significantly larger or smaller.
- When differentiating between smaller and larger schools, please note that largest school must be at least twice as large as the smallest.

- Grade Span X for non-traditional or uncommon grade spans.
  - Example:
    - 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Academy that is in its own building
    - A school that is K-8 while your other schools are in grade spans grouped differently, such as K-5 and 6-8.
- If a district or State charter school only has one building per grade span, they will only fill out form 3A. If there is more than one building per grade span, Form 3B will also need to be completed.







## **Using Comparability Formula**



### **Comparability Formula**

- After the figures have been calculated for the Non-Title I schools, boxes 7B and 8B will contain the numbers used for comparison with the Title I schools. Choose either Measure 7B or Measure 8B and apply it consistently for each Title I School.
- B: Compare the entries in Column 7 for each Title I school to the figure in Box 7B. If all entries in Column 7 are less than the green box in 7B, all schools meet the comparability measure. If one or more entries do not meet the measure, move to Measure 8B.
- Measure 8B: Compare the entries in Column 8 for each Title I school to the figure in Box 8B. If all entries exceed the green box in 8B, they meet the comparable measure.
- If an entry does not meet the comparability measure in either column 7 or 8, mark an X on the same line in Column 9.


\*Please note: All districts must meet the criteria for Comparability each year. If a school(s) is out of compliance, a plan must be implemented to correct it.


