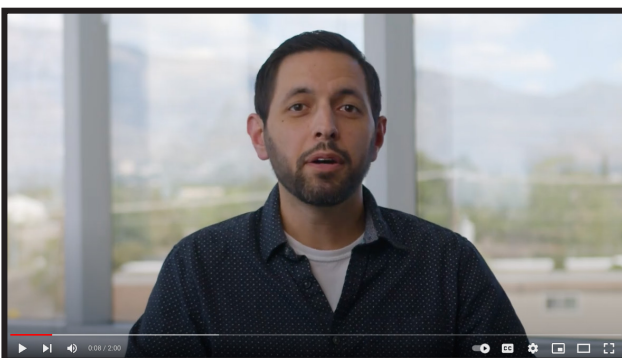
Time Commitment 20-30 minutes
