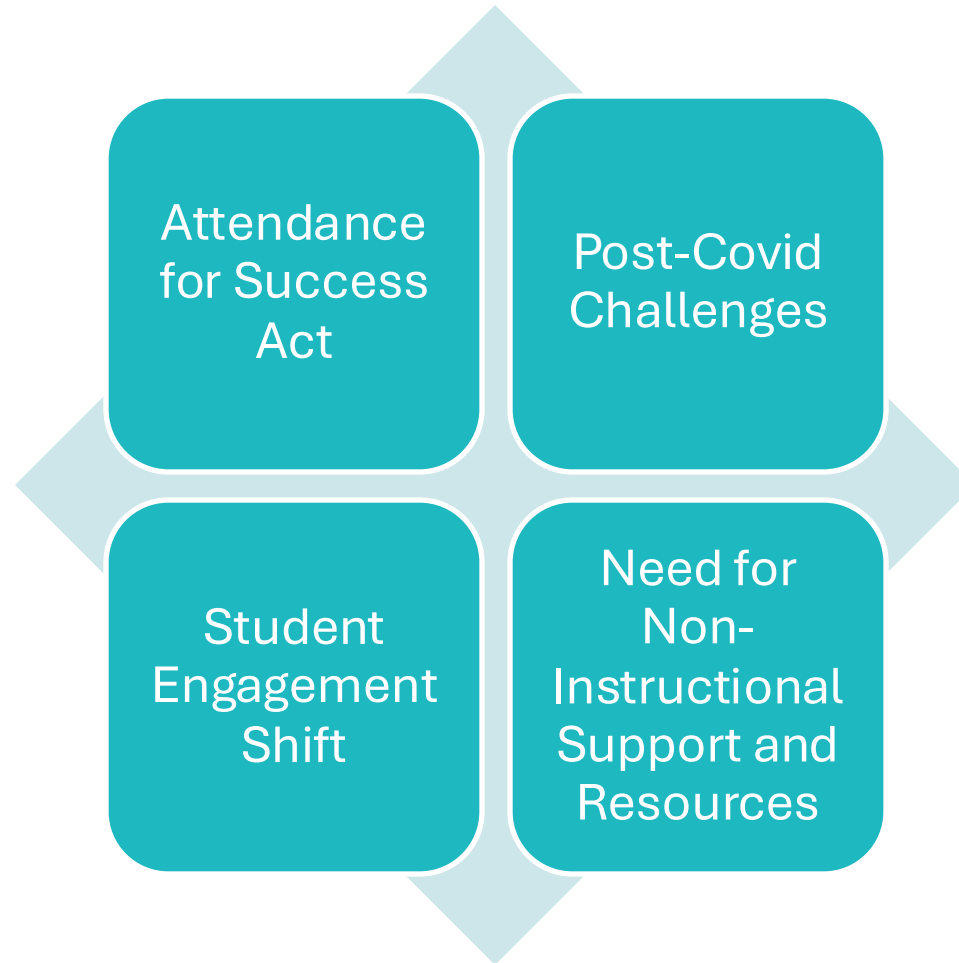




# Attendance Improvement

Disengagement (feeling disconnected, lack of motivation, lack of interest)

Mental health

Transportation

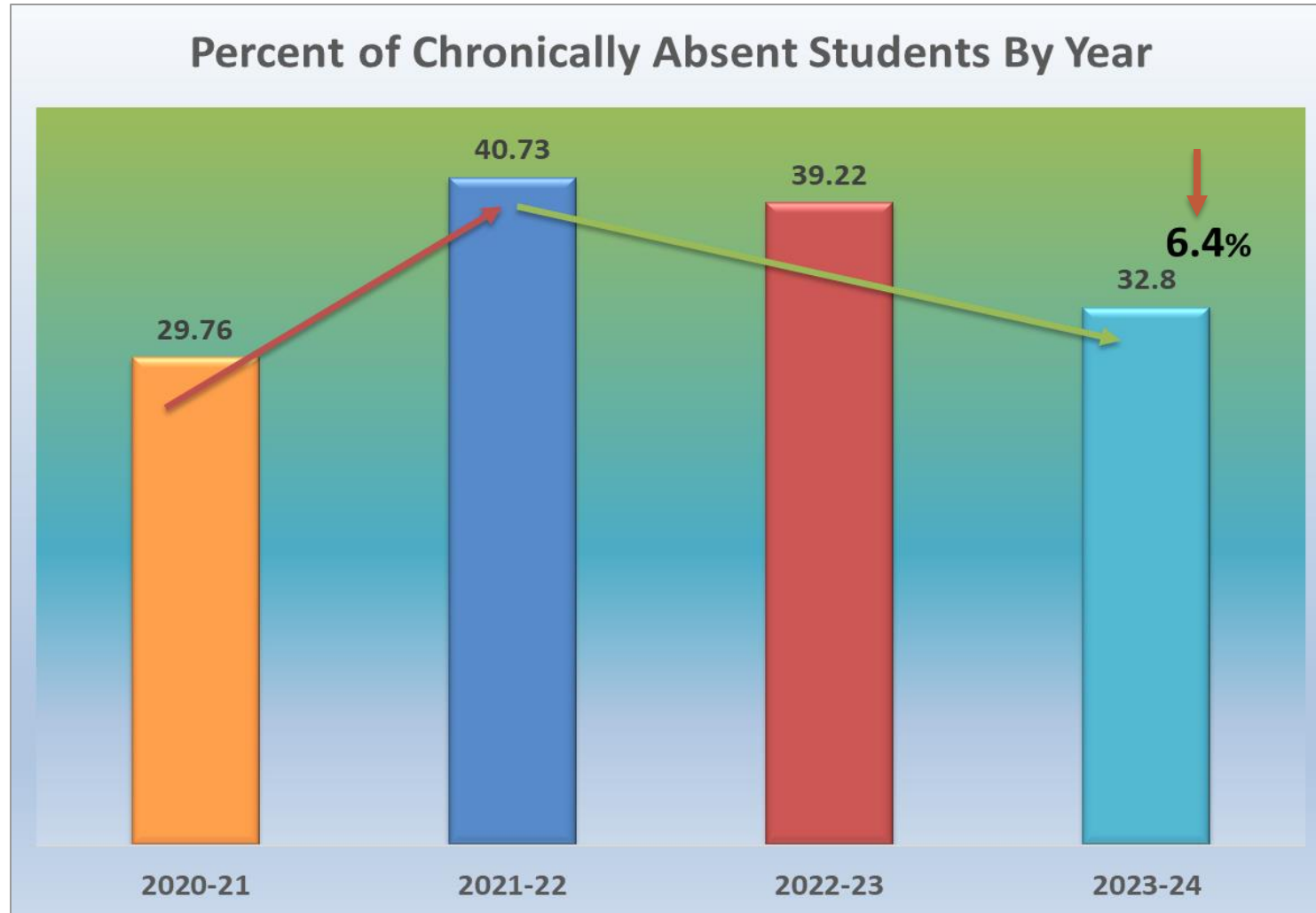
Other (exhaustion from staying up late playing video games, browsing social media, etc.)

## Provided the following support:

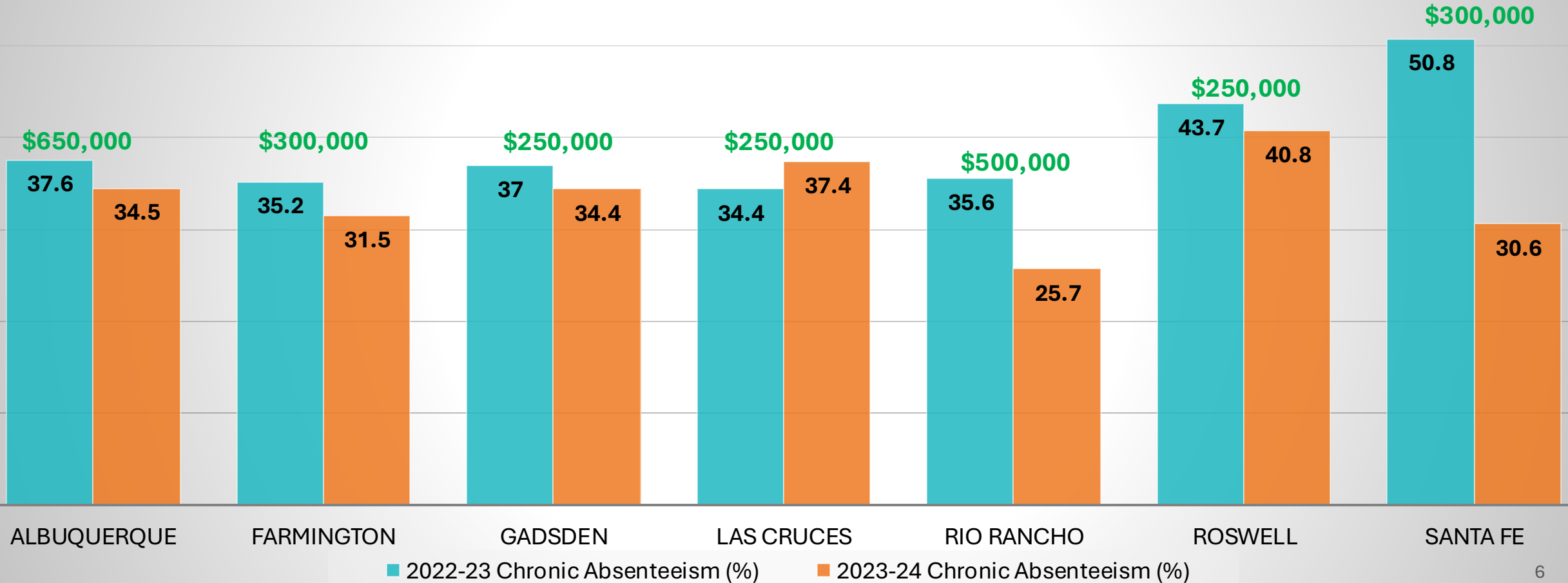

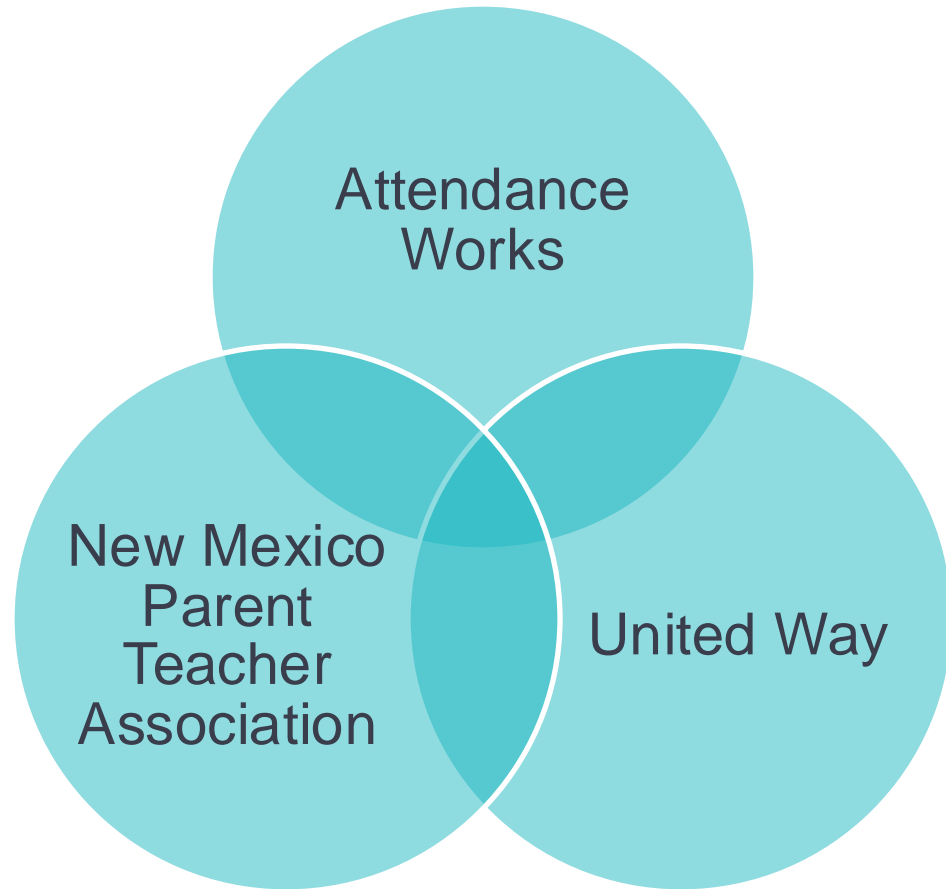

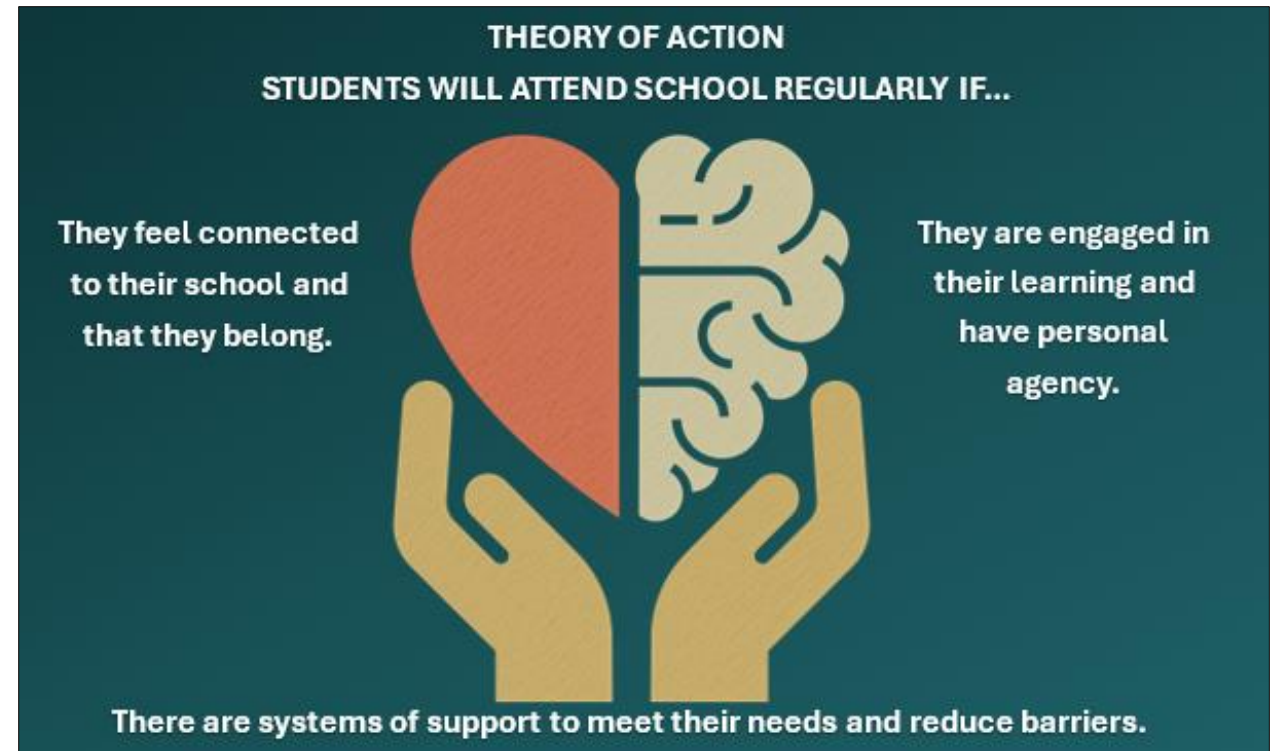

- Improving behavioral health and social-emotional learning (SEL) supports.
- Enhancing connectedness and belonging efforts.
- Increasing family engagement and awareness.
- Improving data-sharing capabilities.

## **Create a dedicated statewide team of five attendance coordinators**

This would allow for more hands-on support by region (Northwest, Northeast, Central, Southwest, Southeast).



## **Enhanced school and district-level information systems to move towards real-time data access**



## **Support the creation and funding of Campus Attendance Interventionist positions**
