Hello. I am Pattie Gipson, Chair of the New Mexico Public Education Commission (PEC). We are the authorizer for New Mexico state charter schools. We will be holding renewal hearings in November related to two schools that have submitted charter renewal applications with the PEC and that are also designated as Indian-Impacted schools with the Navajo Nation being the primary consultation entity.

ACES Technical Charter School	November 12, at approximately 10:30	The Charter Schools Division (CSD) recommends renewal for five years with the following conditions:  1. The school expands Special Education support by hiring at least one licensed Special Education teacher and comply with Office of Special Ed monitoring and technical assistance to make improvements in serving students with disabilities.  2. The school identifies and serves English learners appropriately, correcting all issues identified in the August 13, 2024, Technical Assistance and Focused Monitoring (TAFM) letter from the PED Language and Culture Division (LCD).
The Albuquerque Sign Language Academy	November 13, at 8:00 a.m.	The Charter Schools Division (CSD) recommends renewal with a charter contract term of five years, without conditions

Dził Ditł'ooi School of Empowerment, Action and Perseverance (DEAP) is a third school in this category. Their renewal hearing will be in December. We will follow up with another email closer to that time regarding that school and its renewal hearing.
