## Title III Intent to Apply Form

## The general purpose of Title III

The purpose of Title III subgrants is to help ensure that English learner (EL) students attain English language proficiency and meet the same state standards that all children are expected to meet (ESEA as amended by ESSA, Sec. 3102). A Title III subgrant is supplemental federal funding to increase the effectiveness of a district or state charter schools required EL program.

## Planning allocation

The 2024-2025 Title III planning allocation for a district or state charter school is calculated using the average of the 80<sup>th</sup> and 120<sup>th</sup> day EL student counts as submitted in STARS for the current school year. In the past few years, the Title III planning allocations have averaged approximately \$80 per EL count.

## Minimum threshold requirement

Title III subgrants have a minimum threshold requirement of \$10,000. Districts or state charter schools who do not meet this threshold requirement can enter into a Title III consortium agreement with other districts or state charter schools. The combined planning allocation of the Title III consortium must meet the Title III subgrant threshold of \$10,000.
